Haku Street Sewer Repair Project

It is important to note the Haku Street Sewer Repair Project is currently underway, with the completion date estimated to be March 27, 2025. This project involves stabilizing the cliffside area by removing loose boulders and debris from the sewer easement. Crews will also apply shotcrete, a substance similar to concrete, to reinforce the landscape and stabilize the area using anchors. During construction expect parking restriction on Haku Street, one-lane traffic, along with noise and dust.
