PART II. NARRATIVE

A. PREVENTING, PREPARING FOR, AND/OR RESPONDING TO COVID-19

The Judiciary, State of Hawai'i (Judiciary) like the rest of the state, has been significantly impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. Courts were significantly restricted for three months, and most cases and all trials were postponed. The majority of the Judiciary staff were deployed to work remotely from home during the period of restricted entry to courts. As a result, there is a significant backlog of cases and trials that need to be rescheduled.

As the courthouses reopen, our priority is to ensure the health and safety of staff and court users and minimize the risk of spreading the COVID-19 virus in the courts. New operational protocols were developed in accordance with recommendations from the Center for Disease Control, Hawai'i State Department of Health, and the National Center for State Courts (NCSC), among others. These protocols are also consistent with the announcements and Orders issued by Governor David Ige, the County Mayors, Chief Justice Recktenwald and the Chief Judge in each judicial Circuit.

The NCSC issued guidance in preparation for the reopening of state courts¹ and resumption of court operations² in the wake of the COVID-19 pandemic and resulting restrictions on courts and postponement of cases and trials. Developed in accordance with guidance from federal and state agencies and industry organizations, NCSC's recommendations included:

- Providing additional entry screening including temperature screening for persons entering court facilities.
- Improving wayfinding and circulation within the courthouse reduce the number of people circulating in the courthouse by ensuring they know the direct route to their destination.
- Enforcing social distancing reduce the number of persons entering the courthouse, remind court users about social distancing requirements,

respace/remove seating, stagger workstations, implement one-way circulation in courthouses.

- Ensuring cleanliness clean and disinfect indoor and outdoor areas, require and provide masks and/or other personal protective equipment (PPE), provide easily accessible hand sanitizer in multiple locations; regularly sanitize and wipe down "high touch" areas/surfaces; post signs promoting proper hygiene.
- Rethinking how existing space can be used differently or modified to ensure social distancing can be maintained, use "sneeze guards" (acrylic barriers) and/or install partitions or polycarbonate/plexiglass to create barriers between staff and court users in space-limited areas where social distancing is not physically possible; spread out or consider using rooms for other purposes to gain space.
- Building systems Ventilation and cooling systems play a significant role in reducing the risk of spreading the COVID-19 virus. To promote a healthy indoor environment, consider using portable air cleaners (air scrubbers) with HEPA filters.

Recognizing the significant impact the COVID-19 pandemic has had on the Judiciary's courts and programs, a committee of stakeholders was convened to plan how to best address critical needs in this new, fiscally challenging environment. The Chief Court Administrators, Judges, and the Administrative Department Directors were surveyed to identify the most pressing needs in their circuit or program. Each of the circuits and administrative departments had an opportunity to submit their request for CESF funding based on the unique needs of their court, program, and community. Thus, this proposal is diverse, comprehensive, and responsive.

CESF funding will be used to prevent, prepare for, and/or respond to the COVID-19 as we continue to reopen our courts, address the backlog of court cases, ensure the health and safety of court personnel and users, and minimize the risk of spreading COVID-19 in the courts.

The Judiciary identified the following priority areas for the FY 2020 CESF Program:

- Temperature Verification Kiosks
- Acrylic/Polycarbonate Barriers/Office Partitions
- Technology Hardware
- Translation
- Electrostatic Sprayers/Cold Foggers/Air Purifiers
- Overtime (OT)
- PPE and Sanitation Supplies

Included in this CESF application are the needs and anticipated costs from the following judicial Circuits and Administrative Offices:

- 1. Courts of Appeal (COA)
- 2. First Circuit (O'ahu)

- 3. Second Circuit (Maui, Moloka'i, Lana'i)
- 4. Third Circuit (Hawai'i Island)
- 5. Fifth Circuit (Kaua'i)
- 6. Admin Intergovernmental and Community Relations Department (ICRD)
- 7. Admin Information Technology and Systems Department (ITSD)
- 8. Admin Human Resources Department (HRD)

1. COURTS OF APPEAL (COA)

To appropriately respond to the COVID-19 pandemic and related impacts on the Judiciary's courthouses and court operations, the COA proposes to purchase temperature verification kiosks, office partitions, polycarbonate barriers, electrostatic sprayers and supplies, air purifiers, consultant costs for realignment of office panels and table tops, and OT.

a) Temperature Verification Kiosks

Temperature verification kiosks are stand-alone units that monitor an individual's body temperature if he or she is standing within ½ to one meter of the device. The device will beep and light up if a person's temperature is higher than a specified standard, thus allowing staff to redirect the person before they enter the courthouse. As part of best practices to prevent the spread of infection and the COVID-19 virus, the CDC recommends temperature checks to confirm the absence of fever, one of the symptoms of the virus. Staff can conduct temperature screenings while maintaining social distancing, and prevent individuals with higher temperatures from entering the courthouse. This will help ensure the health and safety of staff and court users and minimize the risk of spreading COVID-19 in the courts. b) Electrostatic Sprayers

Electrostatic sprayers use positive and negative charges to make disinfecting solutions electromagnetically stick to the front, back, and sides of surfaces. Electrostatic application is an efficient, thorough and effective way to disinfect and sanitize surfaces, including hard-to-reach areas. It is safe and effective against COVID-19.

Backpack sprayers will allow staff to efficiently disinfect and sanitize larger areas such as courtrooms, jury rooms, etc. Lightweight, handheld sprayers are sufficient to disinfect and sanitize smaller areas, including offices. Disinfectants used in backpack and handheld electrostatic sprayers are effective in killing bacteria and viruses, including COVID-19. c) Air Purifiers

Air purifiers remove airborne and surface microorganisms within office areas by drawing in potentially contaminated air from the surrounding environment and passing it through a series of filters to remove the contaminants. The air purifiers selected for the COA have a five-stage filtration system and an UV light that helps to destroy bacteria, viruses, and biological impurities. *See, e.g.,* Ultra-Sun SP-20C Portable Air Cleaner (with quote), attached.

d) Acrylic/Polycarbonate Barriers/Office Partitions

The SC Clerk's Office was renovated in 2017, which included the installation of 4' high partitions between four workstations. Adding a stacking, clear extension panel, will raise the height of the existing partitions to create a permanent and protective barrier for the SC Clerk's Office staff. Installing partitions from the same manufacturer will allow us to maintain a safe work environment and conform to industry safety standards.

An acrylic/polycarbonate barrier will be constructed to enclose the reception desk at the entrance to the SC Justices Chambers. Polycarbonate materials meet the fire safety codes and can be secured to the existing fixtures. The reception desk will become a protected, self-contained workstation. The polycarbonate barrier will allow staff seated at the reception desk to have a clear view of visitors and employees while providing a "sneeze guard" barrier between staff and court users. This will help ensure the health and safety of the staff and court users and minimize the risk of spreading COVID-19 virus in the courts.

e) Reconfigure office workstations (move panels and table tops)

Moving panels and table tops for the ICA will provide additional social distancing for 12 law clerks situated in two separate offices. Each law clerk is assigned a partitioned work station and they are all facing in the same direction. By moving the work surfaces and pedestals into a different configuration (e.g., facing a wall vs. all facing the door), the distance between law clerks will be increased to ensure social distancing and reduce potential movement of droplets that may transmit the COVID-19 virus.

f) OT: Hawai'i Bar Exam

OT for four employees (eight hours each) will be required for Saturday, September 12, 2020. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Hawai'i bar examination was rescheduled from July 2020 to September 2020 and will commence from Wednesday, September 9, 2020 through Saturday, September 12, 2020.

The SC Clerk's Office administers the bar exam utilizing test materials developed and distributed by the National Conference of Bar Examiners (NCBE). In a normal year, jurisdictions in all 50 states, the District of Columbia, Guam and the Virgin Islands administer the bar exams simultaneously, during the week of the last Wednesday in February and July. The annual bar exam dates are set by the NCBE. Unfortunately, due to COVID-19, many jurisdictions including Hawai'i did not feel it would be able to safely administer the July bar exam. As a result, the SC granted the Board of Examiners permission to postpone the July exam to a date that was to be determined by the NCBE.

The standard bar exam consists of two-days. The non-standard requests which consist of time and one-half and double-time, will extend the exam schedules to four-days. As a result, our non-standard accommodation applicants will start their exam on Wednesday, September 9, 2020 and end on Saturday, September 12, 2020. Due to the diverse nature of our non-standard requests, the SC Clerk's Office staff need to administer exams in

separate rooms at Ali'iōlani Hale. Eight hours of OT is requested for four employees to administer the bar exam on Saturday, September 12, 2020.

2. FIRST CIRCUIT (O'AHU)

To appropriately respond to the COVID-19 pandemic and related impacts on courthouses and court operations, the First Circuit proposes to purchase temperature verification kiosks; portable air movers, dehumidifiers, and air scrubbers; ultra-low volume (ULV) cold fogger sprayers; and video conferencing and video recording equipment.

a) Temperature Verification Kiosks

Please see discussion of Temperature Verification Kiosks at Section 1. a) above.

As there is currently limited electrical connectivity at the public and private entrances of First Circuit courthouses, it is anticipated that there will be significant, electrical-related expenses related to the installation of these kiosks. Facilities Management estimates it will take eight hours of labor and more than \$500 of materials to set up each kiosk. Construction materials for 32 kiosks will be purchased, but installation for the two kiosks designated for the remote jury selection site (to be determined) and the two backup kiosks will be scheduled at a future date when the units are needed.

b) Portable Filtration Systems (air movers, dehumidifiers, and air scrubbers)

Portable filtration systems remove airborne and surface microorganisms within office areas by drawing in potentially contaminated air from the surrounding environment and passing it through a series of filters to remove the contaminants. Although the size of the coronavirus itself is between .06 and .14 microns, research has shown that HEPA/N95 rated filters (.3 microns) are effective at screening COVID-19 water droplets or aerosols (e.g., saliva, cough, sneeze) that the virus attaches to.

The First Circuit requests three portable filtration systems. Each pack includes: eight (8) large commercial air movers, two (2) small commercial air movers, one (1) dehumidifier, and one (1) air scrubber. See, e.g., B-Air CP-1X Contractor Packs, attached.

• The air scrubber removes airborne particles including viruses, mold, asbestos, dust, pollen, drywall dust, and other miscellaneous debris as small as 0.3 microns (equivalent to an N95 mask), utilizing three stages of filtration including a pre-

filter, optional carbon filter, and a HEPA filter (0.3 microns). Each scrubber is capable of an airflow of up to 500 cubic feet per minute.

- The dehumidifier removes water from the atmosphere.
- The air movers direct airflow within a contaminated room to the air scrubber and/or dehumidifier.

In spring 2020, the First Circuit spent \$288,557.47 for coronavirus-related professional cleaning services at multiple court locations. Purchasing portable filtration systems and other equipment used by the vendor along with training/certification will enable Facilities Management employees to perform cleaning and sanitizing work internally and reduce the need for the First Circuit to contract externally for these costly services.

c) Ultra-Low Volume (ULV) Cold Fogger

Pathogenic microbes such as viruses like COVID-19, fungi, and pathogenic bacteria are the main cause of airborne or direct contact diseases affecting humans. Studies show that the application of disinfectants and biocides via aerosol or fogging significantly reduces the number of viable infectious pathogens, including COVID-19. Foggers produce micro droplets that float in the air for about 10 minutes after application, reaching the most inaccessible parts where conventional cleaning or spraying cannot reach.

ULV cold fog is a well-established spraying technique used in massive aerial spraying campaigns against disease vectors, including the COVID-19 virus. ULV fogging machines are cold fogging machines that use large volumes of air at low pressures to transform the liquid into droplets that are dispersed into the atmosphere. Portable ULV cold fogger sprayers are used to both spray surfaces and the surrounding air for cleaning and disinfecting purposes.

The ULV Cold Fogger features an adjustable hose, high power motor, and quick spraying solution. The equipment will be used with EPA-registered and approved liquid disinfectants. See, e.g., Vector ULV Cold Fogger (with quote), attached.

d) Videoconference/video recording systems for courtrooms

The First Circuit proposes to equip two courtrooms with video conferencing and video recording equipment: Courtroom 3 in Ka'ahumanu Hale (Circuit Court) and Courtroom A in the Kāne'ohe Courthouse.

Courtroom 3 in Ka'ahumanu Hale is the primary courtroom used for hearings involving HOPE probationers. Prior to the pandemic, about 20-30 HOPE probationers a week were transported to Ka'ahumanu Hale from OCCC to attend hearings. From a COVID-19 public health perspective, the transportation of these clients to the courthouse is not advisable and not practical (Ka'ahumanu Hale cellblock capacity is currently four).

The purchase and installation of this video equipment will enable the judge and attorney(s) to participate in the hearing from the courthouse with the defendant participating from OCCC and will allow a video recording of the proceeding to be made for the court record. Currently, only the judge in the courtroom can be seen on video, and only the audio of the proceeding is preserved on record.

The video hardware in Kāne'ohe Courthouse, Courtroom A is over a decade old and inoperable. The Kāne'ohe Courthouse is the Continuity of Operations Planning (COOP) site for the First Circuit. Courtroom A is the designated alternative to handle trials if courtrooms in Ka'ahumanu Hale or Kauikeaouli Hale (Honolulu District Court) become unavailable due to the COVID-19 pandemic or other emergency.

The purchase and installation of this video equipment will enable the judge and other participants physically in the courtroom to participate in video hearings with parties who are not in the courthouse and will allow a video recording of the proceeding to be made for the court record. Currently, only the judge in the courtroom can be seen on video, and only the audio of the proceeding is preserved on record. See Videoconference/Video

e) A/V Equipment to Conduct Remote Jury Selection/Jury Trials

The mobile For The Record (FTR) audio amplification and recording system can be used at various locations, including non-Judiciary facilities (e.g., Hawai'i Convention Center), for the purpose of conducting remote jury selection and jury trials with social distancing and ensuring a clean audio recording for the court record. The equipment includes a computer with FTR recording software, 12 wireless microphones, a wireless transmitter, and a portable loudspeaker system.

Hawaii's State Constitution provides for jury trials in both civil and criminal cases. At the direction of Chief Justice Recktenwald, Chief Judge Browning has asked the Circuit Court to prepare for the resumption of jury trials beginning in September 2020. Due to COVID-19 related social distancing requirements and the limited size of the courtrooms and jury pool room in Ka'ahumanu Hale, the Circuit Court has concluded that it must use outside facilities to conduct jury selection and multi-defendant/high-publicity jury trials. The court is currently considering the use of other court facilities on O'ahu as well as non-Judiciary facilities to conduct juror selection in up to eight cases per week.

Rental of non-Judiciary facilities is costly, and rental of AV equipment at these facilities

is particularly expensive. For example, the daily rate to rent a single microphone at the Blaisdell Center is \$150. Most of the external sites currently under consideration do not have the A/V equipment available to reliably create an audio record of events.

f) OT

Most of the First Circuit's buildings were constructed in the 1980s with limited electrical capacity/connectivity. In the 1980s, the architects did not anticipate the large number of electronic devices and electrical load that are now required at the entrances of the courthouses.

The City and County of Honolulu fire code prohibits the use of extension cords for devices used on a non-temporary basis. The Fire Prevention Bureau advised First Circuit staff that plugging-in devices using an extension cord for even a day would be a fire code violation. The fire code also prohibits "piggybacking" of extension cords in a series. The Honolulu Fire Department website states, "This is commonly found in older buildings that do not contain an adequate number of electrical outlets. Piggybacking is an inspection violation."

In addition, laying electrical cords on the ground is a trip hazard. Occupational Safety and Health Administration Standard 1926.416(b)(2) having to do with electrical cords and cables states: "Working spaces, walkways, and similar locations shall be kept clear of cords so as not to create a hazard to employees."

OT is required to do electrical work related to the installation of the temperature verification kiosks. As there is currently limited electrical connectivity at the public and private entrances of First Circuit courthouses, it is anticipated there will be significant, electrical-related expenses to ensure proper installation of the temperature verification kiosks. The Judiciary Facilities Management Manager estimated it will take eight hours of electrician labor (three hours OT) to properly provide electrical connectivity for the kiosks. The \$511.59 in materials per kiosk we have requested, includes funding for electrical conduit and running the electrical wiring along the wall and ceilings.

The Second Circuit consists of the following facilities on three islands:

• Hoapili Hale (HH)

Address: 2145 Main Street, Wailuku, HI 96793

Description: HH (89,000 sq. ft.) is the main courthouse for the Second Circuit. It is staffed by approx. 150 Judiciary employees and 22 Sheriffs. HH has eight courtrooms, and houses the Law Library, Traffic Violation Bureau, Legal Documents Branch, Juvenile Probation, restitution, community service and other programs. There is also a "cellblock" consisting of four cells to hold in-custody defendants awaiting their hearings and work area for the sheriffs.

• Lahaina District Court (LDC)

Address: 1870 Honoapiilani Hwy, Lahaina, HI 96761

Description: LDC (9,610 sq. ft) services the West Maui community. It has one courtroom, custody cells, conference and witness rooms. Besides Court, LDC provides supportive services including collection of fees and fines.

Molokai District Court

Description: Located in the main town of Kaunakakai. The Moloka'i DC is approx.

400 sq. ft. District and Family Court hearings are held on a regular basis.

Description: The (636 sq. ft) stand-alone building (formerly the Lāna'i Police Station) was recently renovated. Family and District Court hearings are held here.

To appropriately respond to the COVID-19 pandemic and related impacts on courthouses and court operations, the Third Circuit proposes to purchase temperature verification kiosks, electrostatic sprayers and supplies, disinfecting spray, and hand sanitizer dispenser stations and supplies. In addition, OT is required to address the backlogs of cases and other matters resulting from the three-month significant restrictions on courts in the Third Circuit and deployment of staff to work remotely from home, and implementation of new court operations protocols intended to ensure the health and safety of the staff and court users and to minimize the risk of spreading the COVID-19 virus in the courts.

e) OT

OT is required to address the backlog of cases resulting from the recent three-months of significant restrictions on courts in the Third Circuit and the implementation of new COVID-19-related court operations protocols aimed at ensuring the health and safety of staff and court users and minimizing the risk of spreading the COVID-19 virus in the courts.

A description of the tasks to be performed by each position:

- 1) Social Worker IV (4). This is for two positions in Kona and two positions in Hilo, all of which function as probation officers (POs). In the Judiciary, POs are classified as social workers. Currently, due to the COVID-19 pandemic and the resulting three-months of significant restrictions on courts in the Third Circuit, and deployment of staff to work remotely, probation operations have been curtailed. The OT will enable POs to address the backload of regular supervision visits and drug testing, along with catching up with the backload of researching and writing pre-sentence investigation reports, which provide an assessment of convicted defendants and appropriate sentencing recommendations that are relied upon by the court.
- 2) Court Administrator II (2). This is for one position in Kona and one position in Hilo. The Legal Documents Branch maintains the court records for the District, Family and Circuit Courts. Currently, these positions are being primarily tasked with coordinating the flow of persons coming into our facilities, keeping them safe and socially distanced. The OT is required to address the backlog of cases resulting from the recent three-months of significant restrictions on courts in the Third Circuit, and provide supervision of Legal Documents Branch efforts to process the backlog of documents filed with the court.
- 3) Documents Clerk Supervisor (2). This is for one position in Kona and one position in Hilo. The OT is required to review and properly supervise and update the backlog of documents filed during the recent three-months of significant restrictions on courts in the Third Circuit. We are trying to catch up with processing the backlog of documents filed with the court. In addition, preliminary assessment suggests an increase in filings that correlate with timing of the COVID-19 pandemic, such as

- domestic violence temporary restraining orders, evictions, foreclosures, landlord-tenant disputes, and divorces, and anticipate this trend will continue.
- 4) Accountant II (1). This is for one position in Hilo. The OT is required to address the backlog of payments, and to review, audit, issue, and pay current expenditures for the Third Circuit. Required fiscal practices include independent review of payments by two fiscal staff, so OT is needed for multiple fiscal staff. Fiscal staff must act expeditiously to clear the backlog in processing payments resulting from the recent three-months of significant restrictions on courts in the Third Circuit, otherwise, interest will accrue on unpaid amounts. It is critical for fiscal to be able to timely process payments.
- 5) Accountant III (1). This is for one position in Hilo. The OT for this person is similar to item 4 above.
- 6) Account Clerk III (1). This is for one position in Kona. The fiscal positions in Kona are critical as they are only three account clerks on the Kona side (this being one). The OT is required to address the backlog of receipts and payments resulting from the recent three-months of significant restrictions on courts in the Third Circuit. In addition, with the further reopening of the courts and increasing caseloads comes a concomitant increase in the workload of fiscal staff, who collect bail, fines, restitution, court fees and costs as well as issue checks, bail forfeitures, and refunds. Handling of cash requires multiple persons to ensure the necessary checks and balances to maintain a sound financial operation.
- 7) Account Clerk IV (1). This is for one position in Kona and three positions in Hilo. These positions are normally at the Cashier's window, accepting payments and issuing receipts. The OT is required to process the backlog of checks and cash received during the recent three-months of significant restrictions on courts in the Third Circuit, and the anticipated increase in bail, fines and restitution received, resulting from the impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic, including layoffs and loss of income experienced by this vulnerable population, and increase in criminal activity.
- 8) Account Clerk V SR 15 (2). This is for one position in Kona and one position in Hilo. The OT is required to address the backlog of receipts and payments resulting from the recent three-months of significant restrictions on courts in the Third Circuit, including reviewing and auditing the work of lower-classified account clerks (listed above).
- 9) Assistant Court Fiscal Officer I (1). This position is in Hilo. The OT is to address the current backlog and provide oversight of financial transactions in the Third Circuit. The heartbeat of court operations is the handling of money and the proper accounting of it. This position provides highly experienced oversight of all financial transactions in the Third Circuit, to track and ensure that all transactions are audited properly and all disbursements are timely. Due to the recent three-months of significant restrictions on courts in the Third Circuit, there is a backlog of pending transactions that need to be dealt with in the immediate future.

- 10) Circuit Court Clerk II (4). This is for one position in Kona and three positions in South Kohala. These positions are courtroom positions for Family Court. Family Court is one of the busiest divisions and the number of domestic cases rises when there is an economic crisis. The OT will be to address the backlog of cases resulting from the recent three-months of significant restrictions on courts in the Third Circuit. In addition, there has been an increasing number of domestic violence temporary restraining order petitions filed, which require immediate attention and timely hearings.
- 11) District Court Clerk III (3). This is for one position in Kona, one position in Hilo, and one position in South Kohala. These positions are courtroom staff that attend court hearings and produce the minutes of the proceeding and the orders of the court for each case. The OT will be used to address the backlog of cases which were postponed due to the recent three-months of significant restrictions on courts in the Third Circuit, specifically producing court minutes and orders for each court proceeding.
- 12) District Court Clerk II (7). This is for seven positions in Hilo. The OT is required to deal with the backlog of cases resulting from the recent three-months of significant restrictions on courts in the Third Circuit, including preparing case files for the District Judges for court hearings and trials. The backlog will be exacerbated by the need to reschedule cases and trials that were postponed resulting in even more trials impacting their workload.
- 13) Judicial Clerk IV (2). This is for one position in Hilo and one position in South Kohala. These positions prepare the civil and criminal court calendars and maintain the schedule of cases for hearing. The OT is required to deal with the backlog of cases resulting from the recent three-months of significant restrictions on courts in the Third Circuit. Given the number of cases that were deferred and need to be rescheduled, they need additional time to evaluate and prioritize cases in order to schedule hearings and prepare the court calendars.
- 14) Court Documents Clerk (3). This is for three positions in Hilo. The OT is required to address the backlog of cases resulting from the recent three-months of significant restrictions on courts in the Third Circuit. Given the need to reschedule the cases that were postponed while prioritizing urgent cases and those with statute of limitations issues, and the deluge of last-minute filings that is typical of Circuit Court practice, they will need additional time to prepare case files for the Circuit Judges for scheduled hearings and trials.
- 15) Judicial Clerk III (14). This is for six positions in Hilo, five positions in Kona and three positions in South Kohala. The OT is required to address the backlog of cases resulting from the recent three-months of significant restrictions on courts in the Third Circuit and the implementation of new operational protocols aimed at ensuring the health and safety of staff and court users and minimizing the risk of spreading

COVID-19 in the courts. These positions have been redeployed to assist the public and court users in scheduling proceedings and to manage the flow of people and enforce social distancing requirements within the courthouses during court hours (generally 8:00 a.m.–2:00 p.m.). This, in turn, reduces their available work time to do their regular job of maintaining case files and assisting the public and court users. The task of coordinating and maneuvering people throughout the facility will continue as long as the COVID-19 pandemic lasts. OT is required to address the growing backlog of case files resulting from the recent three months, as well as from the reassignment of staff for a portion of their work day, to implement new operational COVID-19-related protocols.

5. FIFTH CIRCUIT (KAUA'I & NI'IHAU)

To appropriately respond to the COVID-19 pandemic and related impacts on courthouses and court operations, the Fifth Circuit proposes to purchase temperature verification kiosks, electrostatic sprayers and supplies, disinfecting spray, hand sanitizer dispenser stations and supplies, and face shields. Polycarbonate barriers will be fashioned, built, and installed in four of six courtrooms in the Fifth Circuit. In addition, OT is required to fashion, build and install the polycarbonate barriers in courtrooms.

To appropriately respond to the COVID-19 pandemic and related impacts on operations, the ICRD proposes to purchase a temperature verification kiosk, webcams, digital voice recorders and related accessories, social distancing markers/signage/stanchions, disinfecting wipes, gloves, and bottles for hand sanitizer; create a Virtual Reference presence; produce translations of COVID-19-related information/signage; install polycarbonate/acrylic barriers; and subscribe to web-based services to facilitate videoconference meetings and webinar broadcasts.

The ICRD is comprised of eight programs/offices.

a) Temperature Verification Kiosks – Children's Justice Center (CJC) Please see discussion of Temperature Verification Kiosks at Section 1. a) above.

7. ADMINISTRATION – ITSD

To appropriately respond to the COVID-19 pandemic and related impacts on operations, the ITSD proposes to purchase four laptops for staff use.

The COVID-19 pandemic has greatly expanded the ITSD tech-support requirements, due to Judiciary staff teleworking and the increased use of teleconferencing and video conferencing to conduct no-contact business meetings and remote court hearings. This rapid evolution in the way courts operate is driving changes in the workplace, and the type of support that staff need and expect from ITSD. To appropriately respond to the increased needs of staff, courthouses, and court operations, the ITSD proposes to purchase four Dell laptop computers (and software), to be shared by ITSD staff.

The laptops will allow staff to work from anywhere; not just tied to their desks, they can now work remotely from home or from other Judiciary locations providing support to end users, thus maximizing the use of their time and expertise. Working from home reduces the number of staff on premises and ensures social distancing for staff in the office. In the event of a COVID-19 situation in the building where IT staff are located, the laptops would allow staff to telework from home or to be relocated to other Judiciary buildings to continue to work. Laptops through the use of their compact cameras and microphones allow IT staff to meet via teleconference to discuss and share information. This will help ITSD become more responsive and flexible to meet the Judiciary's operational needs.

8. ADMINISTRATION - HRD

To appropriately respond to the COVID-19 pandemic and related impacts on Human Resources operations, HRD proposes to purchase and install two workstation cubicles with clear vertical partitions at the entry to the HRD main office, Kapuāiwa Building, 426 Queen Street, Room 103, Honolulu, HI, to minimize possible exposure and contamination when interacting with applicants, vendors, and members of the public who require service, as well as to minimize the cost to install the workstations.

The main office of the Judiciary's HRD (426 Queen Street, First Floor, Kupuāiwa Building, Honolulu, HI 96813) is a high traffic area and is often the first stop for applicants, vendors, mail and parcel delivery, bus pass pickup for staff, and other members of the public who visit the HRD and the ICA for services.

Currently, the workstations located at the entry of Room 103, near the main entry of the HRD, do not have vertical partitions installed. Permanent, clear partitions would minimize the potential exposure of staff from possible COVID-19 contamination by in-person visitors seeking assistance from HRD. Such partitions will protect staff and court users and are necessary to comply with existing social distancing requirements and safety protocols that have been instituted at the Judiciary in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. These partitions should be securely and permanently installed in accordance with existing safety protocols and should be purchased, rather than leased, to ensure long-term compliance.

BUDGET EXPLANATION:

A. Salaries and Wages

1) OT (COA, First, Third & Fifth Circuits)

OT is required for the COA staff because, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Hawai'i bar exam was rescheduled to September 9 - 12, 2020. Four COA staff are required to work eight hours on Saturday, September 12, 2020 to accommodate the non-standard requests and administer the bar exam.

OT is required for First Circuit Facilities Management staff to address limited electrical connectivity at the public and private entrances of First Circuit courthouses to ensure proper installation of the temperature verification kiosks. Facilities Management estimates it will take eight hours of labor (three hours OT) to properly provide electrical connectivity for the kiosks. (Fringe is not being charged to the CESF) 3 hours x 32 kiosks = 96 hours.

OT is required for Third Circuit staff to address the backlog of cases resulting from the three-month significant restrictions on courts in the Third Circuit and the implementation of new COVID-19-related court operations protocols aimed at ensuring the health and safety of staff and court users and minimizing the risk of spreading the COVID-19 virus in the courts.

OT is required for two Fifth Circuit Facilities staff to fashion, build and install polycarbonate barriers in four of six courtrooms in the Kaua'i Judiciary Complex, 3970 Ka'ana Street, Līhu'e, HI. A barrier/shield will be built in front of the Witness box, Judge's Bench, Court Clerk station, and on the Defense Attorney's and Prosecutor's tables. Installation of the barriers will help ensure the health and safety of staff, attorneys and court users and minimize the risk of spreading the COVID-19 virus in the courts.

C. Consultant Services/Contracts

Consultants will be obtained in accordance with State of Hawai'i Procurement Code and internal fiscal procedures established by the Judiciary, for the following:

1) Reconfigure 12 workstations in ICA.

The COA will seek a contractor to reconfigure workstations and move panels and table tops for the ICA to provide additional social distancing for 12 law clerks situated in two separate offices. Each law clerk is assigned a partitioned work station and they are all facing in the same direction. By moving the work surfaces and pedestals into a different configuration (e.g., facing a wall vs. all facing the door), the distance between law clerks will be increased to ensure social distancing and reduce potential movement of droplets that may transmit the COVID-19 virus.

2) Install acrylic/polycarbonate barriers/office partitions in SC Clerk's Office.

The SC Clerk's Office was renovated in 2017 which included the installation of 4' high partitions between four workstations. Adding a stacking, clear glass extension, will raise the height of our existing partitions to create a permanent and protective barrier for the SC Clerk's Office employees. Installing partitions from the same manufacturer will allow us to maintain a safe work environment and conform to industry safety standards. The extended partitions will modify existing space and create a protective barrier for staff seated at their work areas. The partitions will ensure social distancing and block droplets to prevent possible transmission of COVID-19.

3) Install two workstation cubicles with partitions in HRD.

Contractor will install two workstation cubicles with clear vertical partitions at the HRD, Kapuāiwa Building, 426 Queen Street, Honolulu, HI, to ensure social distancing, block droplets and minimize possible exposure and contamination to ensure the health and safety of staff and the public.

4) Translations of COVID-19-related information/signage.

COVID-19-related information/signage will be translated into non-English languages to provide important information to assist limited English proficient court customers.

5) Web-programming subscriptions (Zoom, Asana, Restream).

The JHC will conduct various activities remotely, rather than holding in-person meetings and presenting public educational programs. Zoom and Asana will be used for staff meetings, project management, and public programming webinars. Restream will be used to live-stream public programming webinars to Facebook and YouTube. The subscription is for three services for six months (July-December 2020).

F. Equipment

1) Temperature Verification Kiosks

Temperature verification kiosks will be purchased for the public and staff entrances of courthouses and other Judiciary facilities (i.e., CJC-Oʻahu). Temperature verification kiosks are stand-alone units that will monitor an individual's body temperature if they are standing within ½ to 1 meter of the device, and will beep and light up if a person's temperature is higher than a specified standard, thus allowing staff to redirect the person before they enter the courthouse. As part of best practices to prevent the spread of infection and COVID-19 virus, the CDC recommends temperature checks to confirm the absence of fever, one of the symptoms of the virus.

3) Ultra-Low Volume (ULV) Cold Fogger (First Circuit)

ULV spraying is a well-established spraying technique used in massive aerial spraying campaigns against disease vectors, including COVID-19. 6) First Circuit-Videoconference/Video Recording Systems; Second Circuit Polycom Systems

The First Circuit proposes to equip two courtrooms with videoconferencing/video recording systems: Courtroom 3 in Ka'ahumanu Hale (Circuit Court), 777 Punchbowl Street, Honolulu, HI, and Courtroom A in the Kāne'ohe Courthouse, 45-939 Pookela Street, Kāne'ohe, HI. This request specifically includes: 1) installing and integrating new video equipment in each courtroom; 2) installing three, fixed, wall-mounted cameras for the judge, attorney and witness; 3) a 65" display monitor for members of the jury; 4) Polycom video conferencing system; 5) video switcher to properly route video sources; 6) video out connection for news media access to court proceedings.

Courtroom 3 in Ka'ahumanu Hale is the primary courtroom used for hearings involving HOPE probationers. Prior to the pandemic, about 20-30 HOPE probationers a week were transported to Ka'ahumanu Hale from OCCC to attend hearings. From a COVID-19 public health perspective, the transportation of these clients to the courthouse is not advisable and not practical (Ka'ahumanu Hale cellblock capacity is currently four). Currently, only the judge in the courtroom can be seen on video and only the audio of the proceeding is preserved on record. The purchase and installation of this video equipment will enable the judge and attorney(s) to participate in the hearing from the courthouse with the defendant participating from OCCC, and will allow for video recording of the proceeding for the court records. This will reduce the number of people circulating through the courthouse, minimize the risk of spreading the COVID-19 virus in the courts, and ensure the health and safety of judges, staff, defendants, and other court users.

Courtroom A in the Kāne'ohe District Court, is the Continuity of Operations Planning (COOP) site for the First Circuit. Courtroom A is designed to handle jury trials if courtrooms in Kauikeaouli Hale (Honolulu District Court) or Ka'ahumanu Hale become unavailable due to the COVID-19 pandemic or other emergency. The video hardware in Courtroom A is over a decade old and inoperable. The purchase and installation of this video equipment will enable the judge and other participants physically in the courtroom to participate in video hearings with parties who are participating remotely from their home or other location outside the courthouse, and will allow for video recording of the proceeding for the court records. This will reduce the number of people circulating through the courthouse, minimize the risk of spreading the COVID-19 virus in the courts, and ensure the health and safety of judges, staff, defendants, and other court users.

The Second Circuit proposes to install Polycom systems in two courtrooms in Family Court and in the cellblock at HH, 2145 Main Street, Wailuku, HI.

Family Court Courtrooms 3A and 3B at HH would be upgraded by installing Polycom systems with audio/video integration with the current JAVS system. Installation of this equipment will provide the court with increased capacity to hold court hearings via web conferencing. Parties will be able to participate in hearings remotely, from their own homes or other locations outside of the courthouse, rather than having to appear in person in court. This will reduce the number of people circulating through the courthouse and minimize the risk of spreading the COVID-19 virus in the courts.

Cellblock at HH would also be provided with a Polycom system to allow custody

defendants to participate in court hearings remotely by connecting to the courtroom from the cell block via web conferencing. This will minimize the movement of in-custody defendants within the courthouse, reducing the number of people circulating through the courthouse, and minimizing the risk of spreading the COVID-19 virus in the courts.

7) A/V Equipment for Remote Jury Selection/Trials

The mobile FTR audio amplification and recording system can be used at a spacious, remote location (e.g., Convention Center) for the purpose of conducting jury selection and jury trials. The equipment includes a computer with FTR recording software, 12 wireless microphones, wireless transmitter, and portable loudspeaker system. Due to COVID-19 related social distancing requirements and the limited size of the courtrooms and jury pool office in Kaʻahumanu Hale, the Circuit Court has concluded that it must use facilities outside of Kaʻahumanu Hale to conduct jury selection and multi-defendant/high-publicity jury trials. First Circuit is currently considering the use of other court facilities on Oʻahu as well as non-Judiciary facilities to conduct juror selection in up to eight cases a week.

G. Other Costs

1) Acrylic/Polycarbonate Barriers/Office Partitions

a) Acrylic/Polycarbonate Barrier (COA)

An acrylic/polycarbonate barrier will be constructed to enclose the reception desk at the entrance to the SC Justices Chambers. Polycarbonate materials meet the fire safety codes and can be secured to the existing fixtures. The reception desk will become a protected, self-contained workstation.

b) Acrylic/Polycarbonate Barriers (Second Circuit)

Acrylic/polycarbonate barriers will prohibit droplets from transferring from one person to the next in space-prohibited areas that do not allow for adequate social distancing. Courtrooms will utilize these barriers to provide protection between (1) the Judge and the witness stand and (2) the Court Clerk and the parties. Probation Officers will utilize these barriers to provide protection between staff and probationers.

c) Acrylic/Polycarbonate Barriers, Related Construction Supplies (Fifth Circuit) Acrylic/polycarbonate barriers will be fashioned, built, and installed in front of the Witness box, Judge's Bench, Court Clerk station, and on the Defense Attorney and Prosecutor's tables, in four of six courtrooms in the Fifth Circuit. The purpose is to block droplets to prevent possible transmission of the COVID-19 virus.

Construction supplies (i.e., lumber, brackets, screws, caulking, paint, etc.) are needed to fashion, build and install acrylic/polycarbonate barriers in the courtrooms.

d) Acrylic/Polycarbonate Barrier (CJC-Kaua'i)

An acrylic/polycarbonate barrier will be installed in the client reception area in the CJC-Kaua'i as an infection prevention measure to protect staff and clients.

e) Acrylic/Polycarbonate Barriers/Office Partitions (OEAC)

Acrylic/polycarbonate barriers/office partitions will be installed in the OEAC office to create barriers between co-workers and between staff and the public, to prevent the spread of viruses.

f) Acrylic/Polycarbonate Barriers/Office Partitions (SCLL)

Acrylic/polycarbonate barriers/office partitions will be installed in the SCLL Office and at the circulation counter, to block droplets and minimize the risk of spreading COVID-19 virus.

Construction supplies (i.e., lumber, brackets, screws, caulking, paint, etc.) are needed to fashion, build and install acrylic/polycarbonate barriers in SCLL.

2) Construction Materials for Installation of Temperature Verification Kiosks

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

INVOICING

- A. Invoicing: Balance of merchandise will be invoiced upon delivery. A 1 1/2% per month service charge will be added for invoices unpaid after thirty (30) days from date of invoice.
- B. Delays: if Buyer is unable to receive product at job site on the mutually agreed upon date, product will be deemed delivered and will be invoiced as if delivered.

OTHER CHARGES

- A. Changes/Cancellations: Buyer will pay all additional charges from the manufacturer for order changes. Express orders cannot be changed or canceled. All product is custom manufactured to customer specifications and, therefore, cannot be returned.
- B. Extra handling if site not ready: If job site is not available on mutually agreed upon customer required date, charges will be assessed to Buyer for additional handling of product at standard hourly rate.
- C. If product needs to be stored by Seller longer than 30 days, charges will be assessed to buyer.
- D. Cancellation of installation date: If Buyer cancels agreed upon installation date giving less than four working days notice, Buyer will be charged an additional 15% of the installation cost.
- E. Overtime: Unless otherwise stated, delivery and installation will be made during Seller's normal business hours. Any additional labor costs resulting from overtime work performed by Buyer's request will be paid by Buyer.
- F. Special Packaging or Handling: If special packaging, handling, demurrage, or storage at other than Seller's warehouse is required that is not provided in the specifications, any additional charges will be paid by the Buyer.
- G. Partial Deliveries: Partial deliveries can be made at the request of the Buyer for an additional charge. Unplanned partial deliveries may result in a premium overtime cost.
- H. Legal Fees: Should either party incur any expense in enforcing any terms, covenants, conditions, representations or warranties of the Agreement, the part in default will pay all expenses including reasonable attorney's fees.

DELIVERY AND INSTALLATION

- A. Seller's responsibilities: Seller will receive, inspect, stage deliver and install Buyers goods. All furnishings will be clean and put into working order. Cartooning and packing material will be removed and premises left in good orders. When applicable, Seller may direct shipment directly to the job site.
- B. Damage: After arrival at the site, any loss or damage shall be the responsibility of the buyer, except when the damage is due to the sole negligence of Seller, which is acknowledged by the lead installer.
- C. Freight claims: When sold "delivered and installed", claims for product damaged in transit will be processed by Seller and damaged product will be repaired or replaced to reasonable satisfaction of Buyer.
- D. Drop shipments: In case of drop shipments where product is delivered without installation, Buyer will receive, inspect and install ordered goods as soon as it is delivered. If Buyer does not inspect and make seller aware of any damages within 15 days after Buyer has received product, then Seller can not be responsible to replace damaged goods.
- E. Normal Business Hours: Delivery and installation will be made during Seller's normal business hours 7:30 to 3:30 Monday through Friday, excluding seller's observed holidays and weekends.
- F. Condition of Job Site: Job site will be clean and clear of all obstructions prior to installation. Buyer will provide adequate facilities and space for unloading, staging, moving, handling and storing product at job site.
- G. Job Site Services: Buyer will furnish electrical current, lighting and elevator service at job site without charge to Seller.

- H. Protection of Delivered Goods: Buyer is responsible for security and safekeeping product after delivery at job site.
- Risk of Loss: Upon delivery of product to Buyer's site, or into storage negotiated by Buyer if job site is not ready on mutually agreed upon date, Buyer assumes all risk of loss of delivered/stored product and shall not be released from any obligations under this agreement due to product's loss, damage, or disrepair following delivery/storage.
- J. Delays: If product cannot be delivered to job site on mutually agreed upon customer required date because site is not ready, Buyer's delays, or Acts of God, Seller shall have reasonable time to deliver and install product when site is available after causes of delay have been eliminated.

ADDITIONAL TERMS

- A. Title and Security Interest: Seller retains title to all goods until Buyer has performed all its obligations under this agreement and the purchase price of the good and related services has been fully paid to the Seller. Seller retains security interest in the goods, all accessories, and replacements of the proceeds from the goods as security for the performance by Buyer of all Buyer's obligations arising under this agreement and the purchase order.
- B. Interpretation of Terms and Conditions: This writing is intended by all parties as the final expression of their agreement and is intended also as a complete and exclusive statement of the terms of their dealings between the parties, if any, and no usage of the trade shall be relevant to supplement or explain any term used in this agreement. No failure by any party to insist upon strict compliance by the other party with any of the terms, provisions, or conditions of this Agreement, in any instance shall be construed as a waiver or relinquishment by either part of the other party's right to insist upon strict compliance therewith in the future. Whenever a term defined by the Uniform Commercial Code as adopted in Hawaii is used in this agreement and not otherwise defined, the definition contained in the Code is to control.
- C. Acts Beyond Reasonable Control: Seller shall not be liable for any delay or failure to deliver any or all of the product in case delay or failure is caused by labor disputes, strikes, wars, riots, civil commotion, fire, flood, earthquake, accident, storm or other destruction whole or in part of the product or the manufacturing plant, lack or inability to obtain raw materials, labor, fuel, or any other cause, contingency or circumstances which prevent or hinder the manufacturer or delivery of the product beyond the reasonable control of the seller.
- D. Waiver: No claim or right arising out of a breach of this agreement can be discharged in whole or in part by a waiver or renunciation of the claim or right unless it is supported by a consideration and is in writing signed by the aggreed party.
- E. Assignment and Delegation: No right or interest in this agreement shall be assigned; by either Buyer or Seller without the written permission of the other party, and no delegation of any obligation owed, or of the performance of any obligation either by Buyer or Seller shall be made without the written permission of the other party. Any attempted assignment or delegation shall be wholly void and totally ineffective for all purposes unless made in conformity with this section of this Agreement.
- conformity with this section of this Agreement.

 F. Entire Agreement: This Agreement constitutes the entire contract and exclusively determines the rights and obligations of the parties, any prior course of dealing, custom or usage of trade or course of performance not withstanding. Unless otherwise agreed to in writing between Buyer and seller, this document supersedes all other purchase orders or documents provided by the Buyer. Seller's design, installation and/or service contracts are incorporated herein by reference and shall take precedence on any conflict of terms.
- G. Applicable Law: This agreement and all rights and obligations of the parties shall be governed by the laws of the State of Hawaii.
