How to Drive Through a Roundabout

- As you approach the roundabout, slow down and watch/stop for pedestrians and bicyclists in the crosswalk.
- If there is a vehicle (car or bicycle) in front of you, do not stop your vehicle on the crosswalk.
- Continue toward the roundabout and look left as you near the yield sign and dashed line at the entrance to the roundabout.
- Yield to traffic already in the roundabout.
- Once you see a gap in traffic, enter the circle and proceed to your street exit. If there is no traffic in the roundabout, you may enter without yielding or stopping.
- Look for pedestrians and bicyclists and use your turn signal before exiting.
