This year marked the 30th anniversary of the U.S. Space Shuttle Challenger disaster. Governor Ige declared January 28, 2016 as Ellison Onizuka Day in memory of astronaut Onizuka and his fellow crewmembers.

Born and raised in Kealakekua, Kona, Hawaii, Ellison Onizuka graduated from Konawaena High School in 1964. Lt. Colonel Onizuka was the first Asian American astronaut in space and was a member of the U.S. Space Shuttle Challenger Crew. The crew of the Challenger lost their lives on January 28, 1986.

In commemoration of Ellison Onizuka's life, the State Senate and House issued a joint certificate to the Onizuka family. Claude Onizuka, Ellison's brother, accepted the certificate on behalf of the family.
