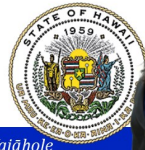

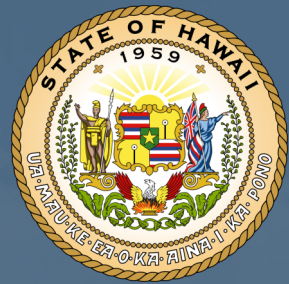

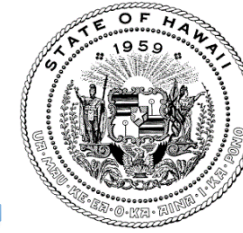

Thank you for the opportunity to continue to serve you in the State Legislature. As we begin 2022, I would like to wish you and your family a year full of good health, peace and joy. The new year affords us an opportunity to reflect on the past and look to the future. 2021, like 2020, was an unprecedented year. COVID-19 has fundamentally changed how we learn, how we play, how we interact, and how we live our lives. MAKE YOUR VOICE HEARD!

How to Engage in the Legislative Session



1. CREATE AN ACCOUNT

Go to: www.capitol.hawaii.gov. On the Home Page, click "Register" and enter your name, email address, and the password you'd like to use for the website. After you've agreed to the terms and conditions, you will be directed to go to your email account and open the email sent to you by the website. Follow the instructions for confirming your account. You'll only have to register once!

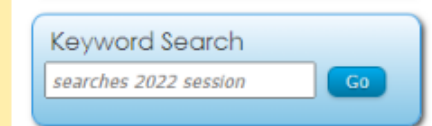
2. SIGN UP FOR HEARING NOTICES

To sign up to receive hearing notices by email on measures (bills/resolutions), click "Hearing Notification". Click on "Subscribe by Measure". Enter the bill or resolution number that you want to track. Click "Subscribe by Committee" and track the committee hearings by selecting "Add". Click "Save and Exit" after inputting your requests.



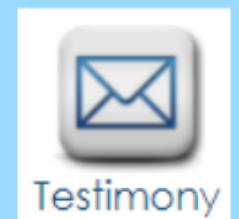
3. SEARCH LEGISLATION

Using the "Keyword Search", you can search through the content of bills, resolutions, and committee reports by entering words or phrases. For help and examples, click on the "How to Use the Searchboxes" link that appears above the boxes.

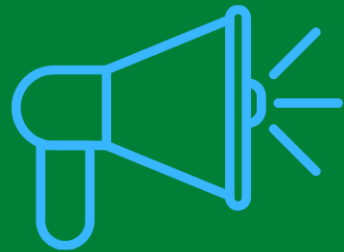


4. SUBMIT TESTIMONY

Click "Testimony". Enter the bill number that you want to testify on. Complete the form and click "Choose File" or "Browse" to upload your testimony file. Click "Submit" when finished. Please note that you are only able to submit testimony if the bill is scheduled for a hearing and if the committee is accepting testimony.
