INCOME TAX REFUND

The Department of Taxation will be implementing the recent income tax refund legislation soon.

The refunds are \$300 or \$100 per taxpayer and qualified dependent depending on Federal Adjusted Gross Income. Refunds will be made in the order in which taxpayers file their returns.

Filing Status	Federal Adjusted Gross Income	Refund Per Exemption (Person)
Single	Under \$100,000	\$300
	\$100,000 and over	\$100
Head of Household	Under \$100,000	\$300
	\$100,000 and over	\$100
Married Filing Joint	Under \$200,000	\$300
	\$200,000 and over	\$100
Married Filing Separate (Both spouses combined)	Under \$200,000*	\$300
	\$200,000 and over*	\$100
Surviving Spouse /	Under \$200,000	\$300
Qualified Widow(er)	\$200,000 and over	\$100

*These federal AGI thresholds for married filing separate filers are combined for both spouses. These filers are eligible for the amount of refund they would be eligible for if they have filed jointly.
