'Aina Haina Land Added to Reserve

The City and County of Honolulu, in partnership with the **Trust for Public** Land, the 'Āina Haina Community Association, and the Wailupe Ohana Council have closed on the purchase of a 9.5-acre parcel of land located in 'Āina Haina. The parcel of land is located at the end of upper Hao Street. The parcel of land will be added to the Wailupe Nature Preserve.

The purchased cost a combination of \$4.1 million from all entities involved in the closing of this purchase. Our office would like to thank the City, the Trust for Public Land, the 'Āina Haina Community Association, and the Wailupe Ohana Council for their tireless efforts to preserve this treasured parcel.

MAKE SURE YOUR ID IS TSA COMPLIANT



The deadline for individuals to get a REAL ID is **October 1, 2020**. Starting October 2020, if you wish to use your REAL ID at the airport, your ID must have a **gold star** on it.

The City has developed a system to allow those who have received their existing ID through the City and County of Honolulu between May 1, 2014 to January 31, 2018 to process their request for a REAL ID online without going into the DMV, as long as there are no changes to your name, address, or anything else on your ID.

For \$7.00, non-REAL ID holders may mail in their ID to receive a temporary one within two to three days, then receive an official one six to eight weeks later.

 - West: June 11-14, 2020 (CA, OR, WA, ID, NV, AZ, NM, MT, WY, CO, UT, AK, HI)
 - Central: July 9-12, 2020 (ND, SD, NE, KS, OK, TX, MN, IA, MO, AR, LA, WI, IL, MS)
- East: August 6-9, 2020 (MI, IN, KY, TN, AL, FL, GA, OH, WV, VA, NC, SC, PA, NY, MD, NJ, DE, CT, RI, VT, NH, MA, ME, PR, VI, DC)
- 2. Attend YP4's Annual National Summit the weekend of February 12–15, 2021.
- 3. Complete a Blueprint for Social Justice (Outline, Draft, and Final).

Application Review and Interviews: March 2-17, 2020
