Post session wrap-up...

The 2015 Legislative Session may be over but the work continues. At the close of the session there was a change in Senate Leadership and as committees were reorganized, I was named Chair of the Senate Transportation and Energy Committee. In 2015, there were 16 committees, but in the 2016 session, there will only be 14. This means that some committees will be a combination of two subject areas—transportation and energy is one of these, and both issues are of particular concern to District 4, Hawaii Island and the State.

I have spent much of this interim in meetings with Transportation and Energy business leaders, lobbyists and experts balanced with attending conferences on the subjects to be better informed and up-to-date. I was a previous Chair for Transportation, but Energy is fast-paced with cutting edge technologies being introduced. Both the production of energy as well as energy storage are critical to our future.

I am proud and humbled to take on this work and hope that constituents will lend support by voicing their opinions on bills referred to this committee, as well as issues of concern specific to our district.
