## Senator Michelle Kidani Selected bills introduced – 2017 Session (Current 3 pm, March 8, 2017)

## **Public Education**

SB 195 - Appropriates funds for staff support positions for the Hawaii Teacher Standards Board

SB 197 – Provides funds for start-up grants for newly-approved, pre-opening public charter schools

SB 199 – Provides funds for teacher bonuses for hard-to-fill placement incentives and Board Certified teacher incentives for charter school teachers

SB 683 – Proposes a Constitutional Amendment to allow the state to establish a fee on residential investment property and visitor accommodations to fund public education.

SB 687 – Expands the scope of the Executive Office on Early Learning and early learning programs to include early childhood development and provides additional authority to the Early Learning Advisory Board

## Child Care

SB 511 – Requires the Department of Human Services to publish reports of child care facility inspections and complaint investigations on the DHS website

SB 512 – Requires child care providers to maintain liability insurance as a condition of qualifying for licensure by the Department of Human Services. [**Note**: my bill has not moved forward, but HB 674 – containing similar provisions – has been passed by the House and sent to the Senate.]

## **Others**

SB 207 – Establishes a program that allows state employees to share unused leave days with other state employees who may need time to deal with serious personal or family illness or injury

SB 1191 - Extends the motion picture, digital media, and film production income tax credit sunset date an additional ten years to January 1, 2029. [Note: my bill has not moved forward, but SB 1086 to extend the tax credit has passed final reading in the Senate and is now before the House.]
