Highway 130 Update In the February edition of my e-newsletter we shared that the DOT is looking at the possibility of adding additional lanes to areas of highway 130 using the existing infrastructure. Ideally, this will help ease congestion by making 4 lanes available for use, with no time restrictions.
