Dengue Fever: What can you do to help eliminate those pesky mosquitoes?

- Eliminate standing water in buckets, puddles, etc.;
- Clear outdoor drains of leaves and lawn cuttings;
- Clean clogged gutters to allow proper drainage;
- Treat bromeliads and other plants that hold water-flush weekly or spray with soapy water or chemical treatments from garden store;
- Fix leaky outdoor faucets;
- Repair screens and jalousie windows to keep mosquitoes out.
