To ensure that you are given the opportunity to vote and not have the post-Iselle problems like we had in the 2014 elections, please vote Absentee or Early Walk-In but please VOTE. You need to register again if you moved EVEN IF you moved within the same district. If you are unsure because you moved back, register anyway.

If mailing absentee ballots; <u>please</u> mail in ballots ASAP or walk ballots in because over 750 ballots were not counted in the August primary due to their late arrival.

Q. MAY I WRITE-IN A CANDIDATE?

A. No, Hawaii is one of six states that do **NOT** allow for any "write-in"s. Doing so spoils the ballot and invalidates the portion of your ballot that has been written on. Checking off too many boxes, spoils your ballot.

If you are aware that you have a spoiled ballot, inform a precinct official, as you will have the option to make corrections.

If you turn in your ballot and the machine notes any errors or "write-ins", the precinct official will inform you of the error. You will have the option to make corrections.

For mail-in voters who submit spoiled ballots, you will be contacted by the election office and you will have the option make corrections.

IF you decide not to make the corrections and leave the ballot as is, the error area will be a "no" or blank vote. Thus, your vote may not be counted for the crucial local races. There were a lot of blank votes in the primary election.
