LEGISLATIVE UPDATES

SB2545 - Relating to Early Education

Establishes the executive office on early learning and the early learning advisory board to replace the early learning council. Repeals junior kindergarten programs at the end of the 2013-2014 school year, but lays the framework for a statewide preschool program. Clarifies that beginning with the 2014-2015 school year, requires students to be at least five years of age on July 31 of the school year in order to attend kindergarten. (Passed out of FIN on April 3)

SB2115/SB2116 - Charter School Omnibus and Transition Plan

Establishes a new chapter governing charter schools & completely re-codifies HRS302B, based on the recommendations of the charter school governance, accountability, and authority task force established by Act 130, Session Laws of Hawaii 2011 & inline with the National Charter School Model Law. Provides resources & time for implementation & transition to the new system. (Passed out of FIN on April 3)

SB2540 Hawaii Revised Statutes; Clean up Bills

Amends or repeals various provisions of chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as part of statutory clean up & streamlining effort. (Passed out of FIN on March 29)

SB 2536 Relating to Clean and Sober Homes and Halfway Houses

Establishes a temporary clean and sober home and halfway house task force. Requires the task force to submit a report to the legislature containing findings and recommendations and any proposed legislation that may be necessary to effectuate those requirements. (Passed out of FIN on March 30)

HB2246 Relating to Haiku Valley

Establishes the Haiku Valley cultural preserve commission to provide policy and management oversight of the Haiku Valley cultural preserve. Initiates process of conveying Haiku Valley in fee simple to the Department of Land and Natural Resources. (Passed out of WAM on March 30)

HB2012 HD1 SD1 - Relating to the State Budget

Enchanted Lake Elementary (2011) \$1,400,000 for campus wide electrical upgrades.

James B. Castle High School (2011) \$585,000 to replace the lighting and sound system in Ron Bright Auditorium.

Kailua Elementary (2011) \$1,400,000 for campus wide electrical upgrades.

Kailua High (2011) \$2,500,000 for removal and replacement of soccer/football field bleachers and storage rooms. (2012) \$360,000 for the plans, design, construction and equipment upgrades for tennis courts.

Kalaheo High (2011) \$1,500,000 for athletic field improvements and (2012) \$410,000 for plans, design and construction of bleachers for athletic field and tennis courts.

Kaneohe Elementary (2011) \$780,000 and (2012) \$780,000 for the plans, design, construction and equipment for ADA transition plan.

Kapunahala Elementary (2012) \$400,000 for the plans, design and construction for covered walkways between buildings A, B, and C.

Olomana School (2011) \$88,000 for the plans, design and construction for a twelve-foot extension to physical education portable.

Puohala Elementary (2011) \$250,000 for plans and design for a structural assessment to address the separation of walls in buildings on campus.

The Senators then respond via video to the students' questions.
