OCCC Funding Updates

The OCCC Laumaka Work Furlough Center (LWFC) has been provided funds for various repairs and improvements, which has not happened since its opening in the early 1990's. Moneys were released to renovate restrooms, showers, and the laundry facility.

In addition, funds were also released for the planning of the relocation of the OCCC, which will go towards providing land funds and planning for the groundwork for the proposed new facility.

OCCC staff manage and operate the LWFC, located a block away from the OCCC. Inmates assigned here are either actively seeking employment or working in the community.
