Funds are transferred into this account when financial benefits are authorized to the Department's clients and are then transferred daily to the DHS' contractor who issues the actual benefits to the clients when they access their accounts electronically.

Source of Revenues: Amounts represent combined federal and general funds. The federal portion of HMS 211 (Temporary Assistance for Needy Families) is funded by DHHS - ACF, TANF Grant and is included in Appropriation Account S-XX-201-K.
