RELATING TO SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER PROTECTION.
Requires businesses, subject to limited exceptions, from disclosing an individual's social security number to the general public; printing the SSN on an identification card or in mailings to customers; and

SSN on an identification card or in mailings to customers; and requiring the transmission of a SSN to third parties without the individual's written consent unless the third party needs the

information for a legitimate purpose.
