SB 2654	RELATING TO SCHOOL FACILITIES. Requires the DOE to establish, maintain, and post on the Internet a list of projected DOE construction projects. Makes appropriation.	EDM, WAM
SB 3196	RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES.  Requires the department of education to divide its school facility capital improvement project priority list into two lists — one for schools 25 years and older, and one for schools under 25 years.	EDM, WAM
SB 2704	RELATING TO EDUCATION. Repeals the school-level minor repairs and maintenance accounts and the annual report of expenditures from the accounts.	EDM, WAM
SB 2837	RELATING TO EDUCATION.  Appropriates \$32,000,000 for schools in the department of education for equipment, supplies, and services. Reimburses each teacher up to \$200 for money spent on classroom and instructional teaching supplies.	EDM, WAM
SB 2836	RELATING TO THE STATE EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES IMPROVEMENT FUND. Increases the amount of money deposited into the state educational facilities improvement special fund.	EDM, WAM
SB 3103	AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS AND MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO REDUCE THE REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE PROJECTS BACKLOG FOR DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION FACILITIES.  Authorizes the issuance of general obligation bonds and appropriates general revenues for the department of education's repair and maintenance projects.	EDM, WAM
SB 2587	RELATING TO EDUCATION. Authorizes special purpose revenue bonds for Kawaiahao school.	EDM, WAM



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SB 3136	RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL PURPOSE REVENUE BONDS FOR SAINT LOUIS SCHOOL. Authorizes the issuance of up to \$15,000,000 in special purpose revenue bonds for Saint Louis School to finance or refinance the planning, acquisition, construction, or improvement of its educational facilities. SB 2535	RELATING TO PEARLRIDGE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL. Amends Act 41, Session Laws of Hawaii 2004, to authorize the use of moneys allocated to the Pearlridge elementary school cafeteria expansion project for renovation, as well as expansion, of the cafeteria.	EDM, WAM
SB 2075	MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR CAMPBELL HIGH SCHOOL. Appropriates funds to provide an air conditioning system for James Campbell High School.	EDM, WAM
SB 3157	AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS AND MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR EXPANSION OF THE MOLOKAI PUBLIC LIBRARY. Authorizes the issuance of general obligation bonds and makes an appropriation to expand the Molokai public library.	EDM, WAM
SB 2452	AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS AND MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR PAHOA HIGH AND INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL. Appropriates general obligation bonds for Pahoa high and intermediate school.	EDM, WAM
SB 2738	AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS TO SUPPLEMENT ANY SHORTFALL TO ACQUIRE LAND TO EXPAND KAHUKU HIGH AND INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL.  Authorizes the issuance of general obligation bonds to supplement any shortfall to acquire land to expand Kahuku high and intermediate school.	EDM, WAM
