HB 2410 HD1 (HSCR646)	RELATING TO CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES. Amends statutory provisions to conform with changes to the Uniform Controlled Substances Act enacted in 2005. (HB2410 HD1)	HTH, JHW
HB 2109 HD1 (HSCR909)	RELATING TO HEALTH. Establishes a fetal alcohol spectrum disorder coordinator position within the Department of Health. (HB2109 HD1)	HTH, WAM

Prohibits the State from denying or interfering with a female's right to choose or obtain an abortion of a nonviable fetus or an abortion necessary to protect the female's life or health.
