SB 2814	RELATING TO TAXATION. Authorizes a county electing to exercise the authority to adopt a county surcharge on state tax to collect the county surcharge on state tax.	IGA/TGO, WAM
SB 2909	RELATING TO PERMIT APPROVALS. Allows a county to opt out of the automatic permit approval law by adopting an ordinance to exempt the county as a whole or any county agency from the law.	IGA/TGO, JHW
SB 2397	RELATING TO IMPACT FEES. Authorizes impact fee imposition on capital improvements for state CIPs. Deletes offsets payable to a developer from factors considered in adopting impact fees. Authorizes the transfer of impact fees assessed for roads and highways to the State for highway projects reasonably benefiting a development.	IGA/TGO, WAM
SB 3134	RELATING TO CHAPTER 281, HAWAII REVISED STATUTES. Corrects various inconsistencies and erroneous references in sections 281-35, 281-41, and 281-94, HRS, relating to intoxicating liquor.	IGA/TGO, JHW
SB 2410	MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE ROADS IN LIMBO PROGRAM FOR THE COUNTY OF HAWAII. Establishes a roads in limbo program to resolve issues relating to certain roads in the county of Hawaii that are not maintained by the State or the county; appropriation.	IGA/TGO, WAM
SB 2411	MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR PLANS AND CONSTRUCTION FOR THE PUNA RECREATIONAL COMPLEX IN PAHOA, HAWAII. Appropriates funds to design and construct a public recreational facility complex in Puna, Hawaii.	IGA/TGO, WAM



SB 2400	<p>MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR PLANNING, DESIGN, AND CONSTRUCTION OF THE KAILUA-KONA SENIOR CENTER IN KAILUA-KONA, HAWAII.</p> <p>Appropriates \$900,000 as a grant-in-aid to county of Hawaii for planning, design, and construction of a senior center in Kailua-Kona on the island of Hawaii.</p>	IGA, WAM
SB 2401	<p>MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO UPGRADE THE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM OF THE HAWAII COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT.</p> <p>Appropriates \$24,000,000 as a grant-in-aid to the county of Hawaii to upgrade the police department's radio system from a VHF system to a 700 MHz trunked radio system with a digital microwave backbone.</p>	IGA, WAM
SB 2402	<p>MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO THE OLD KAILUA AIRPORT PARK IN KAILUA-KONA, HAWAII.</p> <p>Appropriates funds to provide improvements to the old Kailua airport park to create a usable, safe public beach park with recreation-related facilities.</p>	IGA, WAM
SB 2403	<p>RELATING TO EXCEPTIONS TO TORT ACTIONS.</p> <p>Provides specific exceptions to tort actions.</p>	IGA, JHW
SB 2025	<p>RELATING TO COLLECTION OF IMPACT FEES.</p> <p>Increases the period of time in which impact fees are expended or encumbered by counties from six to ten years.</p>	IGA, WAM
SB 2551	<p>RELATING TO INTOXICATING LIQUOR.</p> <p>Authorizes the liquor commission to reduce the time from 30 days to 15 days for giving a decision to grant or refuse an application. Allows commission to remove names from registered voter list for lack of residency. Deems an application denied if the commission does not make a decision granting or refusing an application.</p>	IGA, JHW
SB 2552	<p>RELATING TO INTOXICATING LIQUOR.</p> <p>Deems an application denied if the liquor commission does not make a decision granting or refusing the application.</p>	IGA, JHW
SB 2553	<p>RELATING TO INTOXICATING LIQUOR.</p> <p>Makes the default period for a liquor commission decision 30 days and allows the commission, upon notice, to reduce it to 15.</p>	IGA, JHW
SB 2554	<p>RELATING TO INTOXICATING LIQUOR.</p> <p>Allows liquor commission to remove names from registered voter list when confirming lack of residency.</p>	IGA, JHW
SB 3051	<p>RELATING TO COUNTY FISCAL ADMINISTRATION.</p> <p>Changes the fiscal year for county fiscal administration purposes.</p>	IGA, WAM
SB 2690	<p>RELATING TO DISPOSITION OF CONVEYANCE TAX.</p> <p>Disburses percentage of conveyance tax on properties valued at \$1,000,000 or greater to counties on a quarterly basis to be used as a tax credit for relief to homeowners.</p>	IGA, WAM



SB 2760	<p>RELATING TO PROPERTY LEFT IN A DANGEROUS CONDITION.</p> <p>Establishes civil penalties for property owners who fail to make reasonable efforts at remediation. Authorizes counties to condemn and demolish abandoned facilities damaged due to a natural disaster and place a lien on the property for costs incurred.</p>	IGA, JHW
SB 2856	<p>RELATING TO INSURANCE.</p> <p>Requires each county to adopt ordinance to participate in the Community Rating System of the National Flood Insurance Program.</p>	IGA
SB 3039	<p>RELATING TO ZONING.</p> <p>Requires counties to adopt zoning ordinance to require a minimum per cent of all roof tops on structures in multi-family, hotel, and industrial districts to be landscaped; provides tax credit for added cost of roof top landscaping for taxable years beginning after 12/31/07.</p>	IGA, WAM
SB 2584	<p>RELATING TO COUNTIES.</p> <p>Extends statute of limitations for actions against a county for damage or injury from 6 months to 2 years.</p>	IGA, JHW
