DECISION MAKING ON THE FOLLOWING MEASURE(S):

SB 2938	RELATING TO COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION. Requires that community organizations such as neighborhood boards and community associations be notified when halfway houses, clean and sober homes, or drug rehabilitation homes are being proposed to be situated in their community.	IGA/HMS, JHW
SB 2551	RELATING TO INTOXICATING LIQUOR. Authorizes the liquor commission to reduce the time from 30 days to 15 days for giving a decision to grant or refuse an application. Allows commission to remove names from registered voter list for lack of residency. Deems an application denied if the commission does not make a decision granting or refusing an application.	IGA, JHW
SB 2552	RELATING TO INTOXICATING LIQUOR. Deems an application denied if the liquor commission does not make a decision granting or refusing the application.	IGA, JHW
SB 2553	RELATING TO INTOXICATING LIQUOR. Makes the default period for a liquor commission decision 30 days and allows the commission, upon notice, to reduce it to 15.	IGA, JHW
SB 2554	RELATING TO INTOXICATING LIQUOR. Allows liquor commission to remove names from registered voter list when confirming lack of residency.	IGA, JHW
SB 2584	RELATING TO COUNTIES. Extends statute of limitations for actions against a county for damage or injury from 6 months to 2 years.	IGA, JHW
SB 2233	MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR A CITIZENS POLICE TRAINING PROGRAM. Appropriates funds as a grant-in-aid to Honolulu police department for a citizens police training program to be conducted at least once a year in a location convenient to Oahu residents, particularly in communities seeking to expand citizen participation in fighting neighborhood crime. SB 2350	<p>RELATING TO THE DEPOSIT BEVERAGE CONTAINER SPECIAL FUND.</p> <p>Fund litter control programs by counties, their contractors, or their volunteers.</p>	IGA, WAM
SB 2430	<p>RELATING TO ELECTION.</p> <p>Directs judiciary to notify county clerk of a felony conviction at time of actual sentencing of the felon.</p>	IGA, JHW
SB 2559	<p>RELATING TO ETHICS.</p> <p>Clarifies that members of county boards and commissions are subject to the respective county code of ethics, regardless of whether the board or commission member is appointed or elected.</p>	IGA, JHW
SB 2560	<p>RELATING TO INSTANT RUNOFF VOTING.</p> <p>Provides for instant runoff voting for all county elections in which no primary election is held. Defines "instant runoff method". Provides for method of voting, counting votes, and certifying results using the instant runoff method.</p>	IGA, JHW
SB 2073	<p>RELATING TO THE POWER OF ARREST.</p> <p>Extends the power of federal officers to make arrests under state law, currently limited to Customs and Immigrations Service officers, to include agents of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, Drug Enforcement Administration, Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives, United States Secret Service, and United States Marshal Service.</p>	IGA, JHW

SB 2583	<p>RELATING TO HIGHWAY HAZARD EVALUATION DATA.</p> <p>Prohibits discovery of safety hazard analysis. Clarifies that the motor vehicle accident reports completed by the police of the various counties is included in the prohibition against discovery. Permits the release of source data.</p>	IGA, JHW
