## DECISION MAKING ON THE FOLLOWING MEASURE(S):

(Deferred from Friday, February 10, 2006)

SB 3022 RELATING TO EMPLOYMENT SECURITY LAW. LBR/IGA, WAM

Removes the requirement that funds appropriated to the county of Hawaii workforce investment board be expended for the eradication of

coqui frogs and other invasive species. Removes the timeline requirement for the release of funds under Act 249, SLH 2005.

SB 3020 RELATING TO HEALTH INSURANCE. LBR/IGA, WAM

Requires the State and counties to provide health insurance to its emergency and temporary hires and part-time employees who work less than twenty hours a week who would otherwise not have health

insurance coverage.

SB 2665 RELATING TO FIRE PROTECTION. TGO/IGA

Excludes state-owned airport facilities from inspection duties of the

county fire chief.

SB 2218 RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION. TGO/IGA, WAM

Requires DOT, to the extent practicable, to comply with county outdoor lighting ordinances at airports, harbors, and highways and to provide fully shielded lens fixtures on all outdoor lighting fixtures.
