RELATING TO THE UNITED STATES SENATE.

Requires that, after receiving notice of a U.S. Senate vacancy from the

governor, the chair of the political party in which the previous

incumbent held membership shall submit to the governor the names of not less than three nominees to fill the vacancy. Requires the governor to fill the vacancy by appointing an individual from the list of

nominees within five days. (HB2455 HD1)
