HB 2208 HD1 (HSCR653)	RELATING TO COUNTIES. Extends statute of limitation for actions against a county for damage or injury from 6 months to 2 years. Permits the counties to identify, by charter, the person to whom claimant should give notice of claim for injuries or damage sustained on public property or as a result of the negligence of county official or employee. (HB2208 HD1)	IGA, JHW
HB 2715 HD1 (HSCR736)	RELATING TO POLICE OFFICERS. Creates an annual allowance to police officers for the maintenance of uniforms, equipment and weapons. Appropriates funds to the counties to assist in providing the allowance. (HB2715 HD1)	IGA, WAM
HB 2455 HD1 (HSCR657)	RELATING TO THE UNITED STATES SENATE. Requires that, after receiving notice of a U.S. Senate vacancy from the governor, the chair of the political party in which the previous incumbent held membership shall submit to the governor the names of not less than three nominees to fill the vacancy. Requires the governor to fill the vacancy by appointing an individual from the list of nominees within five days. (HB2455 HD1)	IGA, JHW
