SB 2145	RELATING TO THE ENVIRONMENT. Requires OEQC to contract with the UH environmental center to perform a comprehensive review of the EIS process. Appropriates money to DOH to fund the contract. Appropriates money for the Environmental Council to hire a program director to coordinate the State's environmental justice activities.	EIA/JHW, WAM
SB 3159	RELATING TO THE ISLAND OF KAHO OLAWE. Appropriates funds to install renewable energy systems for a model kahua kauhale or encampment on Kaho olawe and to enable ongoing evaluation of renewable resources for the island.	EIA/JHW, WAM
JHW/EIA	RELATING TO AN ENVIRONMENTAL COURT.	THIS ACT A STARA
SB 3175	Establishes environmental courts as divisions within the circuit court to handle complaints, administrative appeals, and other judicial proceedings of an environmental nature.	JHW/EIA, WAM
JHW SB 1294	RELATING TO PUBLIC LAND TRUST REVENUES. Allocates a portion of public land trust revenues to the repair and maintenance of the Royal Mausoleum. Establishes that the allocation	JHW, WAM

SB 2424	RELATING TO THE OFFICE OF HAWAIIAN AFFAIRS. Deletes the requirement for a comprehensive master plan in Chapter 10, HRS, and replaces it with the office of Hawaiian affairs strategic plan.	JHW
SB 2948	RELATING TO THE PUBLIC LAND TRUST. Appropriates funds to satisfy the State's obligation to pay the office of Hawaiian affairs its pro rata share of revenues derived from the public land trust.	JHW, WAM
SB 2935	AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF HAWAIIAN HOME LANDS AND MAKING AN APPROPRIATION. Authorizes the issuance of general obligation bonds to fund the building of a Hawaiian community center facility in Kapolei by the department of Hawaiian home lands.	JHW, WAM
SB 3119	RELATING TO HAWAIIAN HOME LANDS. Allows the Hawaiian homes commission to deposit moneys in depositories other than the state treasury. Authorizes the Hawaiian homes commission to manage, invest, and reinvest moneys in the trust fund. Authorizes the commission to hold, purchase, sell, assign, transfer, or dispose of any securities and investments and any proceeds	JHW, WAM
