RELATING TO CONSUMER CREDIT REPORTING AGENCIES.

Allows consumers who are victims of identity theft to place a security freeze on their credit reports which will prohibit a consumer reporting agency from releasing any information to unauthorized parties without

the consumer's express consent and provide consumers more control

over who has access to their credit report.

Decision Making to follow, if time permits.
