SB 2558 RELATING TO THE HAWAII RULES OF EVIDENCE.

Makes oral or written apologies inadmissible to prove fault and preserves admissibility of a statement of fault.

SB 3262 RELATING TO HEALTH.

(SSCR2182) Establishes a new chapter that protects the public health and welfare by

prohibiting smoking in public places and places of employment, ensuring a consistent level of basic protections statewide from

exposure to secondhand. Repeals chapter 328K.

SB 3279 RELATING TO MEDICAL LIABILITY. HTH, JHW

SD1 (SSCR2140)

Makes benevolent gestures regarding a medical error inadmissible as evidence of an admission of liability in medical malpractice claims.

RELATING TO FLAVORED TOBACCO PRODUCTS.

Prohibits the sale and distribution of flavored cigarette products.

RELATING TO CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD CHECKS.

SD1 Requires criminal history record checks on persons providing care or
