RELATING TO PROTECTION FROM SECURITY BREACHES. SB 2290 CPH/MAT, JHW SD1 Requires businesses that experience a security breach to notify affected (SSCR2532) people of the breach. (Proposed SD2) SB 2292 RELATING TO DESTRUCTION OF PERSONAL INFORMATION CPH/MAT, JHW SD1 RECORDS. (SSCR2513) Requires businesses that maintain or possess personal information of (Proposed SD2) Hawaii residents to protect against unauthorized access to or use of the information after its disposal by destroying the personal information. SB 2289 RELATING TO CONSUMER CREDIT REPORTING AGENCIES. CPH/MAT, JHW SD1 Allows consumers who are victims of identity theft to place a security (SSCR2472) freeze on their credit reports which will prohibit a consumer reporting (Proposed SD2) agency from releasing any information to unauthorized parties without the consumer's express consent and provide consumers more control over who has access to their credit report. SB 3021 RELATING TO EMPLOYMENT PRACTICES. LBR, JHW SD1 Prohibits an employer from discharging or otherwise punishing an (SSCR2421) employee for the lawful use of the employee's accrued and available sick leave. (SD1) RELATING TO EMPLOYMENT SECURITY. SB 3033 LBR, JHW SD1 Establishes job security requirements to protect employees when the (SSCR2422) business for which the employees work is sold or transferred to another employing entity. (SD1) SB 3016 RELATING TO PREVAILING WAGES. LBR, JHW SD1 Allows a joint labor-management committee established pursuant to (SSCR2287) the federal Labor Management Cooperation Act of 1978 to institute an

action for injunctive and other relief against an employer that fails to

pay its employees the prevailing wage. (SD1)

SB 2986 SD1 (SSCR2195)	RELATING TO EMINENT DOMAIN.  Provides regulations for property taken by eminent domain. (SD1)	WLA/IGA, JHW
SB 3191 SD1 (SSCR2196)	RELATING TO EMINENT DOMAIN.  Prohibits use of power of eminent domain to take and transfer private property to a private entity that had an expressed interest in purchasing the same property for development purposes or other private use. (SD1)	WLA/IGA, JHW
SB 3094 SD1 (SSCR2186)	RELATING TO THE LAND COURT.  Provides that a landowner may not file claim for accreted lands caused by landowner's planting and maintaining vegetation on the seaward boundary of the property affected. (SD1)	WLA, JHW
SB 2551 SD1 (SSCR2399)	RELATING TO INTOXICATING LIQUOR. Authorizes the liquor commission to extend the time from 30 days to 45 days for giving a decision to grant or refuse an application. Allows commission to remove names from registered voter list for lack of residency. Deems an application denied if the commission does not make a decision granting or refusing an application. Exempts hearings from chapter 91. (SD1)	IGA, JHW
SB 2430 SD1 (SSCR2407)	RELATING TO ELECTION.  Directs judiciary to notify county clerk of a felony conviction at time of actual sentencing of the felon. (SD1)	IGA, JHW
SB 2161 SD1 (SSCR2524)	RELATING TO FOSTER CHILDREN. Establishes a foster children's bill of rights. (SD1)	HMS, JHW
SB 2162 SD1 (SSCR2429)	RELATING TO FOSTER CHILDREN. Allows foster children to apply for a driver's license with the written consent of the Department of Human Services. Requires the child's biological parents to pay for vehicle insurance and provides for free insurance if the child's parents cannot pay. Allows higher education board allowances to be paid directly to former foster children. (SD1)	HMS, JHW
SB 2166 SD1 (SSCR2430)	RELATING TO MINORS. Allows a minor under certain circumstances to consent to the provision of medical care and services. (SD1)	HMS/HTH, JHW
SB 3254 SD1 (SSCR2237)	RELATING TO HOME AND COMMUNITY-BASED SERVICES. Removes the sunset date for the licensing of home and community-based case management agencies and the certification of community care foster family homes until. (SD1)	HMS, JHW
SB 2615 SD1 (SSCR2542)	RELATING TO CHILD PROTECTION.  Affirms the importance of kinship placement and a child's attachment and bonding with a kin or non-kin foster caregiver. Requires the department of human services to make a good faith effort, which includes consulting with the Na Kupuna Tribunal, to identify family members for possible placement of a child. (SD1)	HMS, JHW

SB 2688 SD1 (SSCR2434)	RELATING TO CORRECTIONS. Requires implementation of policies and procedures, protocols, and a quality assurance program to ensure adequate youth correctional facility staff training. Provides for comprehensive assessments of all persons committed to youth correctional facilities. Revises duties and responsibilities of regional advisory boards. (SD1)	HMS, JHW
SB 3233 SD1 (SSCR2235)	RELATING TO PARENTING PLANS.  Authorizes the court or the parties to change a parenting plan at any time during the minority of the child without requiring a material change of circumstances. (SD1)	HMS, JHW
SB 3219 SD1 (SSCR2234)	RELATING TO COMMUNITY PLACEMENT. Directs the departments of health and human services to maintain an inventory of all facilities licensed or certified under their jurisdiction and their vacancies to facilitate the placement of individuals in community-based facilities. (SD1)	HMS/HTH, JHW
SB 2188 SD1 (SSCR2213)	RELATING TO A COMMISSION ON FATHERHOOD. Replaces the director of the office of children and youth with the director of public safety, or a designee, as a member of the commission. (SD1)	HMS, JHW
SB 3200 SD1 (SSCR2231)	RELATING TO CHILD PROTECTION.  Provides immunity from prosecution for leaving an unharmed newborn at a hospital, fire station, or police station within seventy-two hours of its birth. Provides immunity for personnel receiving a newborn.  Requires medical history from a person relinquishing a newborn.  (SD1)	HMS, JHW
SB 2328 SD1 (SSCR2217)	RELATING TO NOTICE TO FOSTER PARENTS FOR CHAPTER 587, HAWAII REVISED STATUTES, CHILD PROTECTIVE ACT HEARINGS.  Authorizes a child's current foster parents to attend and participate as parties in all Child Protective Act proceedings subsequent to a disposition hearing. (SD1)	HMS, JHW
SB 2332 SD1 (SSCR2338)	RELATING TO HOUSING.  Amends the definitions of "public housing project" and "tenant" for purposes of evictions from federal public housing. Amends references to the time period in which a public housing tenant has to request a grievance hearing in the written notice of eviction to conform to the recently amended grievance procedure rules. Amends reference to public housing project or complex in the residential landlord-tenant code. (SD1)	CPH/HMS, JHW
SB 2327 SD1 (SSCR2216)	RELATING TO CHILD ABUSE OR NEGLECT REPORTING. Requires staff members of public or private schools, agency, or institutions who, in their professional capacity, have reason to believe that child abuse or neglect has occurred, or that there exists a substantial risk that a child may be abused or neglected in the foreseeable future, to immediately report the abuse or neglect directly to the DHS.	HMS, JHW

SB 2443 SD1 (SSCR2220)	RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A TASK FORCE TO DETERMINE VISITATION RIGHTS FOR GRANDPARENTS AND HANAI INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE INFORMALLY RAISING THESE CHILDREN.  Establishes a joint legislative task force to determine visitation rights of grandparents and hanai individuals who raise grandchildren they have informally raised when biological parent is unable to do so. (SD1)	HMS, JHW
SB 2938 SD1 (SSCR2406)	RELATING TO COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION. Requires that community organizations such as neighborhood boards and community associations be notified when halfway houses, clean and sober homes, or drug rehabilitation homes are being proposed to be situated in their community. (SD1)	IGA/HMS, JHW
SB 2079 SD1 (SSCR2468)	RELATING TO CHILDREN. Establishes a motor vehicle violation that prohibits leaving a child unsupervised in a motor vehicle. Requires the examiner of drivers to test driver's license applicants for knowledge of this offense. (SD1)	HMS, JHW
SB 2213 SD1 (SSCR2053)	RELATING TO TORT ACTIONS.  Makes effective minor's waiver of liability for injuries from use of motorsports facilities; provides qualified immunity to a public entity and public employees from injuries from such use. (SD1)	TGO/BED, JHW
SB 2215 SD1 (SSCR2293)	RELATING TO USE OF INTOXICANTS WHILE OPERATING A MOTOR VEHICLE. Increases sanctions for driving with a high blood alcohol level. (SD1)	TGO, JHW
SB 2385 SD1 (SSCR2312)	RELATING TO HIGHWAY SAFETY.  Increases the penalties for motorists who violate Hawaii's crosswalk law. (SD1)	TGO, JHW
SB 2746 (SSCR2149)	RELATING TO OUTDOOR ADVERTISING. Prohibits advertising on a vehicle engaged in business when the vehicle is operated or parked in a public place, or private place if viewed from a public place, if the primary purpose is advertising.	TGO/IGA, JHW
SB 2712 SD1 (SSCR2026)	RELATING TO ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE. Clarifies quorum requirement under sunshine law to allow for action to be taken by a majority of the number of members to which a board is statutorily entitled minus vacancies. (SD1)	TGO/IGA, JHW
