## DECISION MAKING ON THE FOLLOWING MEASURE(S):

(Deferred from Friday, March 17, 2006)

HB 771 RELATING TO SEXUAL OFFENDERS. **JHW** HD1 Provides that repeat sexual offenders who have been convicted on two prior and separate occasions for an offense under section 707-730, (HSCR769) 707-731, 707-732, or 707-733.5 shall be placed on lifetime parole upon release from prison. (HB771 HD1) HB 877 RELATING TO CRIME. JHW HD2 Separates the multiple offenses of varying severity currently found in (HSCR766) section 134-6, HRS, relating to firearms and ammunition into separate sections to assist in accurate record keeping and setting of bail. Adds related class B and C felonies to the list of offenses for which criminal charges may be instituted by written information. (HB877 HD2 HB 1171 RELATING TO CRIMINAL IMPERSONATION. JHW Establishes the offense of criminal impersonation, making it a petty HD1 (HSCR770) misdemeanor to impersonate another person. (HB1171 HD1) HB 1738 RELATING TO COMMUNITY RESTITUTION. JHW HD1 Changes the term "community service" to "community restitution". (HB1738 HD1) (HSCR754) HB 1746 RELATING TO ELECTIONS. JHW, WAM Requires office of elections to establish a vote-by-mail pilot program. HD1 (HSCR793) (HB1746 HD1) HB 1756 RELATING TO PROBATE. JHW HD2 Requires an attorney preparing a will or trust who has been named to (HSCR823) serve as a personal representative or a trustee, and who anticipates being paid to serve, to disclose in writing to the testator or trustor that the attorney anticipates being paid to serve as personal representative

or trustee, and the method by which compensation will be determined.
