HB 1871 RELATING TO CONSUMER CREDIT REPORTING AGENCIES. CPH/MAT, JHW HD1 Allows victims of identity theft to place a "security freeze" on their (HSCR672) consumer reports, thereby prohibiting a consumer reporting agency from releasing information about the individual without the individual's express consent. (HB1871 HD1) HB 2330 RELATING TO SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER PROTECTION. CPH/MAT Prohibits businesses, subject to limited exceptions, from disclosing an HD1 individual's social security number to the general public, printing the (HSCR661) SSN on an identification card or in mailings to customers, requiring the transmission of a SSN to third parties; and selling or otherwise disclosing the SSN third parties without written consent. (HB2330 HD1) HB 2256 RELATING TO CONSUMER PROTECTION. MAT/CPH, JHW HD1 Prohibits the unauthorized access to or control of a computer or the (HSCR938) inducing, by misrepresentation, authorized person to load software. Authorizes attorney general or prosecuting attorney to seek up to \$2,500 per violation. Authorizes private action to recover \$5,000 per violation or 5 times the amount of damage cause, whichever is greater. (HB2256 HD1) HB 2535 RELATING TO OFFENSES AGAINST PROPERTY RIGHTS. MAT/CPH, JHW (HSCR679) Amends offense of use of a computer in the commission of a separate crime by including use of a computer to obtain control over the property of the victim or to facilitate commission of the offense of theft in the first or second degrees.
