HB 2746 HD3 (HSCR924-06)	RELATING TO AVIATION FUEL TAXES. Exempts aviation fuel from excise, use, and fuel taxes under certain circumstances. (HB2746 HD3)	TGO, WAM
HB 2075 HD1 (HSCR731-06)	RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION. Earmarks a percentage of federally allocated moneys from the state highway fund for bikeways. (HB2075 HD1)	TGO, WAM
