DECISION MAKING ON THE FOLLOWING MEASURE(S):

(Deferred from Wednesday, March 15, 2006)

HB 487 RELATING TO TAXATION. TGO, WAM HD1, SD1 Exempts from GET and use taxes the fuel used in interstate and intrastate air transportation by common carriers. (SD2) (SSCR1140) (PROPOSED SD2) HB 2746 RELATING TO AVIATION FUEL TAXES. TGO, WAM HD3 Exempts aviation fuel from excise, use, and fuel taxes under certain (HSCR924) circumstances. (HB2746 HD3) HB 2075 RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION. TGO, WAM HD1 Earmarks a percentage of federally allocated moneys from the state (HSCR731) highway fund for bikeways. (HB2075 HD1) HB 3087 RELATING TO PROCUREMENT. TGO/HTH, WAM HD2 Gives the Hawaii Health Systems Corporation (HHSC) more (HSCR867) autonomy regarding procurement matters by designating the chief executive officer of HHSC as the chief procurement officer. Raises the amount for which a purchase may qualify as a small purchase from \$25,000 to \$50,000. (HB3087 HD2) MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR HURRICANE HB 3123 TGO/HTH, WAM HD1 PREPAREDNESS.

Funds a study to assess the structural integrity of each hospital and nursing home facility to determine their ability to withstand hurricanes.
