HB 2183 HD1 (HSCR900)	RELATING TO EMERGENCY SHELTERS. Authorizes the issuance of general obligation bonds to fund retrofit of public school buildings to enable them to be used as emergency shelters. (HB2183 HD1)	TGO/EDM, WAM
SCR 12 SR 2	REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE TO PRESENT A HOMELAND SECURITY PLAN TO THE LEGISLATURE.	EDM/TGO
