SB 2923

RELATING TO HARBORS.

WLA.

Authorizes the DLNR to increase issuance of commercial permits in state boating facilities and to limit issuance of commercial permits in small boat harbors if permits create a negative impact on public health

or the environment.

SB 2198

RELATING TO CONSERVATION AND RESOURCES.

WLA

Requires the department of land and natural resources to hold a public hearing prior to allowing the public to use a privately leased launching

ramp, pier, wharf, or landing.

Decision Making to follow, if time permits.
