## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII NATIONAL GUARD.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Section 121-39, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 amended to read as follows: 2 "\$121-39 Pay of officers and warrant officers while on 3 active duty. Officers and warrant officers of the army or air national quard while on active duty of the State shall receive 5 the pay and allowances of officers and warrant officers of 6 similar grades of the United States [army] Army and [air force,] 7 Air Force, respectively; provided that [no]: 8 (1) The State shall allow officers and warrant officers to 9 directly deposit their pay by electronic means to 10 their personal banking accounts; and; 11 No pay or allowances shall be made to officers or (2) 12 warrant officers for any service for which they 13 receive military pay and allowances from the United 1.1
- SECTION 2. Section 121-40, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 16 amended to read as follows:
