## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII RULES OF EVIDENCE.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 626-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by adding to Article IV a new rule to be appropriately  
3 designated and to read as follows:

4           "Rule       Admissibility of expressions of sympathy and  
5 condolence. Evidence of statements or gestures that express  
6 sympathy, commiseration, or condolence concerning the  
7 consequences of an event in which the declarant was a  
8 participant is not admissible to prove liability for any claim  
9 growing out of the event. This rule does not require the  
10 exclusion of an apology or other statement that acknowledges or  
11 implies fault even though contained in, or part of, any  
12 statement or gesture excludable under this rule."

13           SECTION 2. This Act does not affect the rights or duties  
14 that matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that  
15 were begun, before its effective date.

16           SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.


17           SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
