SB 188 SD2, HD1 (HSCR1502)	RELATING TO THE SMALL BUSINESS REGULATORY FLEXIBILITY ACT. Amends Small Business Regulatory Flexibility Act by requiring a small business impact statement to be submitted to the Small Business Regulatory Review Board as early as possible in the review process. Requires the board to notify a small business that they may complain to the ombudsman if the decision is to uphold an agency rule. Expands board duties to include review of any proposed new or amended rule. Makes housekeeping amendments. (SB188 HD1)	EDB, CPC/JUD
SB 1116 SD1, HD1 (HSCR1371)	RELATING TO RENTAL APPLICATION FEES. Regulates the imposition of rental application fees by landlords. (SB1116 HD1)	HSH, CPC/JUD
SB 1419 SD1, HD1 (HSCR1435)	RELATING TO GASOLINE PRICE GOUGING. Protects consumers from price gouging in the purchase of gasoline during periods of abnormal disruption of the marketplace caused by extraordinary adverse circumstances. (HD1)	EEP, CPC/JUD


DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW
