(HSCR878) | RELATING TO MONEY TRANSMITTERS.
Exempts foreign banks that are licensed under U.S. laws or any state which are supervised as financial institutions from the provisions of the Money Transmitters Act. Authorizes the Commissioner of Financial Institutions to provide reports and other information relating to the examination of money transmitters to certain state agencies having regulatory authority over a money transmitter, and to other state and federal agencies for use in investigating civil or criminal charges against a money transmitter. HD1
(HSCR1076) | RELATING TO DESIGN PROFESSIONALS.
Requires a claimant or the claimant's attorney to file a certificate of merit before making a claim against a design professional for failure to meet the standard of care. Requires the filing of a preliminary expert opinion affidavit. (HB1518 HD1) | CPH, JDL |

Persons wishing to testify should submit testimony in one of the following ways at least 24 hours prior to the hearing:


- In person: 30 copies of their testimony to the committee clerk, Room 219, State Capitol.

Please indicate to which committee the testimony is being submitted, the date and time of the hearing, and the number of copies needed for submittal. In addition, please provide the testifier's name and mailing address in the email. Email sent to individual offices or any other Senate office will not be accepted.
