| SB 1315 | RELATING TO THE ACCESS HAWAII COMMITTEE.
Continues the State's oversight of the Internet portal manager permanently (Access Hawaii Committee). | EDT, WAM |

| SB 1688 | RELATING TO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT.
Establishes a supplemental grant program of \$10,000,000 for follow-on research and development project funding for Hawaii-based small businesses that received federal funding in fiscal year 2007 through the Hawaii Technology Development Venture or the National Defense Center of Excellence for Research in Ocean Sciences. | EDT, WAM |
