SB 1222	RELATING TO INCOME TAXATION. Establish that all energy technology systems must be installed and placed in service in the State of Hawaii to obtain energy tax credit.	ENE, EDT, WAM
SB 985	RELATING TO TAX CREDITS. Provides a tax credit for the purchase of a hybrid motor vehicle.	ENE, EDT, WAM
SB 731	RELATING TO FUEL TAX. Specifically exempts the fuel tax for non-transportation fuel uses.	ENE, EDT, WAM

Prohibits sales of restricted use pesticides to a structural pesticides applicator unless the applicator is employed by a licensed pest control

operator.
