HB 1207	RELATING TO DISHONORED PAYMENTS. Increases and standardizes the service charge assessed and collected against dishonored checks and other payments received by the State. Authorizes enforcement by bonded collection agency. Repeals interest on service charge.	FIN
HB 1225	RELATING TO SALARY PAYMENTS. Eliminates the need for the Governor to physically sign paychecks.	FIN
HB 1287	RELATING TO UNCLAIMED PROPERTY. Eliminates the permanent escheatment of unclaimed property to the State.	FIN
HB 513	RELATING TO GRANTS-IN-AID. Provides for the lump sum or installment repayment of a grant-in-aid received by an organization that was used for the purchase of land when the activities for which the grant was made are discontinued on the land acquired and the land is sold or leased by the organization	FIN
HB 122	RELATING TO STATE FUNDS. Requires online full disclosure of all entities and organizations receiving state funds.	FIN


DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW
