HB 1658	RELATING TO THE ANTARA MEDICAL TRUST FUND. Provides an income tax credit for investment in the Antara medical trust fund. Creates the Antara medical trust fund.	FIN
HB 869 (HSCR200)	MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR A STUDY ON ENERGY EFFICIENT TRANSPORTATION STRATEGIES. Makes appropriation to the University of Hawaii, Hawaii energy policy forum, to study energy efficient transportation strategies.	EEP, FIN
HB 110 HD1 (HSCR752)	RELATING TO HOUSING. Appropriates funds for the University of Hawaii to develop student housing.	FIN
HB 310 HD1 (HSCR757)	RELATING TO TECHNOLOGY. Establishes a statewide wireless access task force to study the feasibility of creating a state owned and operated wireless network.	FIN
HB 275 (HSCR507)	RELATING TO THE UNIFORM ATHLETE AGENTS ACT. Enacts the Uniform Athlete Agents Act to protect student-athletes and educational institutions from potential harm caused by unscrupulous athlete agents. Requires athlete agents to register with department of commerce and consumer affairs.	HED, CPC, FIN
HB 1009 HD1 (HSCR195)	RELATING TO CLAIMS AGAINST THE STATE. Makes an appropriation to the department of education to settle pending class action lawsuits brought by part-time and substitute teachers against the department of education of unpaid wages.	JUD, FIN
HB 1367 (HSCR444)	RELATING TO SALARIES. Eliminates statutory relationships between the salaries of specific department heads and deputy department heads and certain civil service positions.	LAB, FIN

RELATING TO A LIVING WAGE FOR WORKERS ON SERVICE LAB, EDB, FIN
CONTRACTS.

Reduces from \$25,000 to \$5,000 the applicability threshold of service contract wage, hour, and working condition requirements.
Grandfathers nonprofits. Requires wages providing an annual income of at least the U.S. poverty guideline for Hawaii for a family of four.
Includes provisions enhancing employees' ability to organize.


DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW
