SB 994 SD1 (HSCR1281)	RELATING TO SEAWATER AIR CONDITIONING DISTRICT COOLING SYSTEMS. Allows the sale of cooling from seawater air conditioning district cooling systems to qualify for state enterprise zone benefits.	EEP/EDB, FIN
SB 1920 SD2, HD1 (HSCR1459)	RELATING TO TAXATION. Improves the administration and transparency of the Motion Picture, Digital Media, and Film Production Tax Credit. Repeals the Hawaii Television and Film Development Board.	TAC/EDB, FIN
SB 1221 SD2, HD1 (HSCR1393)	RELATING TO AGRICULTURAL TAXATION. Establishes the important agricultural lands agricultural business tax credit.	AGR/EDB, FIN
SB 707 SD2, HD1 (HSCR1503)	RELATING TO A NEW MARKET'S TAX CREDIT. Provides a new markets tax credit of 13 percent of the amount paid to a qualified community development entity located in Hawaii to make a qualified equity investment. Requires taxpayer to have received an allowance of credit under section 45D of the Internal Revenue Code, the federal new markets tax credit.	EDB, FIN
SB 1222 SD3, HD1 (HSCR1318)	RELATING TO INCOME TAXATION. Establishes that all energy technology systems must be installed and placed in service in the State of Hawaii to obtain the State's income tax energy tax credit. Also expands tax credits applicable to shareholder pro rata shares in S corporations.	EEP, FIN


