RELATING TO ASSET BUILDING.
Establishes a self-sufficiency standard that will determine the assistance allowance. Establishes a refundable state earned income tax credit. Provides financial education to TANF applicants and recipients. Expands the provision of individual development accounts. Appropriates funds.

RELATING TO TAXATION.
Establishes a food tax credit to be claimed against a resident taxpayer's income tax liability for the amount of \$ multiplied by the number of qualified exemptions to which the taxpayer is entitled.

RELATING TO INCOME TAX CREDIT.
Provides a mandatory tax credit to taxpayers pursuant to article VII, section 6 of the Constitution of the State of Hawaii.

RELATING TO ELECTRONIC FILING OF TAX RETURNS.
Requires that the department of taxation, by rule adopted pursuant to chapter 91, Hawaii Revised Statutes, shall require the electronic, telephonic, or optical filing of tax returns under certain conditions; provides that a service fee shall not be required.

RELATING TO TAX SYSTEMS.
Establishes integrated tax services and management special fund to receive revenues from the integrated tax services and management systems post-implementation revenue-generating initiatives; provides that moneys in the fund will be used to pay for the integrated tax information management systems.


DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW
