RELATING TO CHILD PROTECTION.

HSP, JDL

(HSCR1142)

Provides immunity from prosecution for persons leaving an unharmed newborn at a hospital, fire station, or police station, or with emergency medical services personnel, within 72 hours of birth. Provides immunity from liability the hospital, fire station, police station, or personnel who receive the newborn. Requires that the individual leaving the newborn provide written information on the family medical history of the child. Requires personnel to make a reasonable effort to obtain certain information pertaining to the child from the person leaving the child. (HB1830 HD2)

RELATING TO CAREGIVING.

HSP, WAM

Strengthens support of family caregivers by, among other things: extending the joint legislative committee on family caregiving, requiring the executive office on aging to conduct a comprehensive assessment of care recipients' needs and the needs of their family caregivers, and appropriating funds to expand services for care recipients and their family caregivers. (Proposed SD1)
