SB 236

RELATING TO CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES.

HTH, JDL

Makes pseudoephedrine a schedule V controlled substance requiring a

prescription.

SB 257

RELATING TO CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES.

HTH, JDL

Prohibits pre-signed and predated prescriptions. Clarifies how the narcotic enforcement division administrator shall conduct inspections

at pharmacies.

SB 811

RELATING TO PRESCRIPTION DRUGS.

HTH, CPH

Makes rebate agreements between drug manufacturers and department of human services mandatory. Requires the department to inform health care providers about drug costs for manufacturers with rebate

agreements and those without rebate agreements.

SB 818

RELATING TO PRESCRIPTION DRUGS.

HTH, CPH, WAM

Requires quarterly reports that disclose the average wholesale price, wholesale acquisition cost, average manufacturer price, and best price for each of the manufacturer's drugs from manufacturers of certain

prescription drugs dispensed in this State.

SB 819

RELATING TO PRESCRIPTION DRUGS.

HTH, JDL

Allows consumers, the State, and other affected parties to obtain an injunction, damages, and other relief when a drug manufacturer or its

licensee sells prescription drugs for an excessive price

SB 240

RELATING TO NEUROTRAUMA.

HTH, WAM

Allows money from the neurotrauma special fund to be used for direct services to individuals with neurotrauma; requires the department of human services to apply for a federal waiver for the use of moneys

from the fund.

SB 810	RELATING TO WAIMANO RIDGE. Issues general obligations bonds for capital improvements to the Waimano ridge facilities and lands. Appropriates funds to support the Waimano ridge task force for operating expenses and for a comprehensive masterplan.	HTH, WAM
SB 852	RELATING TO EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES. Appropriates funds for additional urgent care services in the Ocean View and Volcano communities of the island of Hawaii.	HTH, WAM
SB 952	RELATING TO KAHUKU HOSPITAL. Requires the Hawaii health systems corporation to acquire Kahuku hospital on negotiated terms. Requires the director of health to assume a facilitating role during the transition period. Appropriation.	HTH, WAM
SB 1260	RELATING TO A GRANT TO KAHUKU HOSPITAL. Appropriates \$950,000 as a grant to Kahuku hospital from the emergency appropriation approved by the legislature during the regular session of 2007 to permit it to maintain operations and cover costs of reorganization and to transfer to the Hawaii health systems corporation.	HTH, WAM
