SB 1110

RELATING TO HEALTH.

HTH

Requires a hospital, including a public health facility, to provide

information and emergency contraception to a sexual assault victim;

requires training; includes penalties.

SB 1117

RELATING TO HEALTH.

HTH

Requires recipients of state funding that provide sexual health education to provide medically accurate, factual information that is age-appropriate and includes education on both abstinence and

contraception.

SB 1750

RELATING TO HEALTH.

HTH

Requires a hospital, including a public health facility, to provide information regarding shaken baby syndrome to the parents of all

newborns under its care.

SB 653

RELATING TO HEALTH CARE.

HTH

Requires health care facilities and providers to notify the state designated protection and advocacy entity or agency prior to transferring a patient to an out-of-state health care facility.

Decision Making to follow, if time permits.

When faxing, please indicate to whom the testimony is being submitted, the date and time of the hearing, and the required number of copies needed for submittal.
