WLH, JUD

Makes permanent the temporary liability protection of state and county governments for public use of certain public beach parks and the acts or omissions of lifeguards. (SB1603 HD1)

Persons wishing to offer comments are requested to submit **5** copies of their testimony at least 24 hours prior to the hearing to:


