Allows police officers to receive a maximum retirement allowance that shall not exceed 100% of their average final compensation.


DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW

WHEN FAXING, PLEASE INDICATE TO WHOM THE TESTIMONY IS BEING SUBMITTED, THE DATE AND TIME OF THE HEARING, AND THE REQUIRED NO. OF COPIES THAT IS NEEDED FOR SUBMITTAL.
