Authorizes state historic preservation division of department of land and natural resources to require, for any proposed land developments, a comprehensive cultural impact study that recognizes, conserves, and develops the historic and cultural heritage of the State as an important asset for the enrichment of all of the State's residents. HB 610	RELATING TO CULTURAL IMPACT STUDIES. Triggers requirement of conducting a cultural impact study whenever an environmental impact statement is also required for land development.	EDB/TAC, WLH, FIN
HB 1018	RELATING TO LIQUOR. Establishes a condominium hotel class of liquor license.	EDB/TAC, FIN


DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW


