| HB 155 HD1 (HSCR935) | RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION. Requires the Department of Transportation, to the extent practicable, to comply with county outdoor lighting ordinances that are more stringent than other laws and regulations at airports, harbors, and highways. (HB155 HD1) | TIA/IGM, WAM |
| HB 357 HD2 (HSCR938) | RELATING TO TRAFFIC SAFETY. Establishes a pilot project to test crosswalk safety enhancements and programs in the city and county of Honolulu. (HB357 HD2) | TIA/IGM, WAM |
| HB 657 HD1 (HSCR940) | RELATING TO WAIVER OF ABANDONED VEHICLE PUBLIC AUCTION REQUIREMENTS. Allows the waiver of public auction of a towed vehicle that has not been claimed and the vehicle is missing major components or is so materially damaged as to render the vehicle inoperable and the registration period has expired for the vehicle. | HB 1092 HD1 (HSCR862) | RELATING TO EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS. Appropriates funds to the Department of Transportation to purchase back-up generators to ensure continuous electrical power at state airports and commercial harbors. (HB1092 HD1) | TIA/IGM, WAM |

HB 277 RELATING TO FEES FOR WINDSHIELD PLACARDS FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES. IGM/TIA, WAM
HD1 Requires the counties to deposit all fees for temporary and replacement disabled parking removable windshield placards into the State general fund. (HB277 HD1)

HB 1138 RELATING TO FIRE PROTECTION. IGM/TIA
(HSCR753) Clarifies that the responsibility of the county fire chief or designees does not extend to inspection of state-owned airports.

HB 349 RELATING TO COUNTY REGULATION OF COMMERCIAL BICYCLE TOURS. IGM/TIA/EDT
(HSCR836) Authorizes the counties to regulate both guided and unguided bicycle tour businesses on state and county highways.


- In person: 25 copies of their testimony to the committee clerk, Room 205, State Capitol.

Please indicate to which committee the testimony is being submitted, the date and time of the hearing, and the number of copies needed for submittal. In addition, please provide the testifier's name and mailing address in the email. Email sent to individual offices or any other Senate office will not be accepted.
